<p>1 SANITA ANITA R1 (1:00 PT) 40 MDN CLM 50K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 AND COUNTING 6-1 11 OUT OF CONTROL 10-1 8 MERITOCRACY 5-1 5 CAT'S DESIRE 6-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 2 AND COUNTING</u> Much is changing for this one. Drops down in class, moves to the dirt and in the barn of Dan Blacker for the first time. She does have turf breeding so unlikely to improve on the surface change. Has shown speed going long. Might forget to stop in this one.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 11 OUT OF CONTROL</u> Was bet down to 5-2 in the debut due to the fact that the trainer (David Hofmans) had a couple of first time winners recently. Was off slow and never threatened. Ran on the lead in last for the new connections. He'll be coming from near last in this race. He's been very good since he was claimed for 40k six starts back. He beat Eddie Haskell in the 100k Cal Flag Stks 3 back. Clockers very high on his worktab.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 MINISTER OF SOUL</u> There is no question that he has the talent to beat these. The main question is about the turf. He faded in his only turf try which came at RP at 5F. There is turf in the blood. Second dam ran 3rd on this turf at this 6.5F distance in a stakes in 95. Ran well in two of the three starts first off the claim (both were on sloppy tracks). The race two back is a key race. Voided claim by the vet. Light weight with the bug rider. Rail is a concern.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 COPPER COWGIRL</u> Showed good speed in the last few starts. She is another one who gets light weight in here due to an apprentice up. Well-beaten by Heloise two back but that came over the wet track. Should be sent right out in here and may open up. He has the best speed and will attempt to clear off early. Van Dyke was up for the wire to wire win last out. Beaten head by Stormy Liberal (2x BC Turf Sprint Champ) in the G3 Eddie D.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 ARMS RUNNER</u> He's 3 for 4 on the turf at this distance with the only defeat coming off a long layoff last May when a fast closing 4th. Ran 4th on the grass in last and that was a nice run considering there is no turf breeding here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 10 JAMMING EDDY</u> Cal-bred has been facing open class MSW runners in Florida. Shuffled back in last at 18-1 and lost all chance. Winner two back ran 2nd in the 75k Pasco at TAM next out w/ a Beyer of 85. Have to respect anything that Miller sends out. Lost ground on the turn two back when 3rd to SY Sky at long odds. Trainer has been pretty live in many of her starts. Excellent turf rider is aboard.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 QUEEN BEE TO YOU</u> Was second to SY Sky in the Sunshine Mill Turf Sprint two back and in front of the top choice. That made her 5 for 9 in the exacta in her career. Came back to win strongly in the opt clm on the dirt in last. Doesn't see very good field and has beaten many here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 10 ENCOUNTRRESS</u> The two starts in maiden claiming on a fast dirt track where good enough to win. Ran a strong third in the same race the top pick is out of two back. She was making up a lot of ground late there. Off slow three back in race where she got up for 3rd.
