<p>1 SANTA ANITA R1 (1:00 PT) 74 OPT CLM 57K, 1M TURF</p> <p>1 KITTY BOOM BOOM 5-2 4 HOT ON THE TRAIL 3-1 6 AN EDDIE SURPRISE 2-1 2 SEDAMAR 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 KITTY BOOM BOOM</u> She is a full sibling to the 465K turf winner Ambitious Brew (for the same ownership). Professional win in last start to break her maiden as first start on the grass. Cal-bred catches a soft field when facing winners in here for the first time. Repeat of last wins.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 HOT ON THE TRAIL</u> Moved to the grass first off the claim and it shouldn't have come as a surprise as she's bred for the turf with Nureyev bloodlines. She was steadied in the Cal Cup Oaks as a 28-1 chance in last. Off slow two back. She deserves a look first time on a firm course.</p> <p>A) 1,4 B) 2,6 C) 3,5</p>	<p>2 SANTA ANITA R2 (1:33 PT) 59 MSW 55K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>6 ALL GOOD 5-2 3 NOLDE 3-1 2 AIR BOSS 4-1 1 BENNY THE JET 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 ALL GOOD</u> Baffert trained the sibling, Plum Pretty, the winner of the 2011 Kentucky Oaks. Off slow in the debut and he never got into it. Again slow from the gate in last. Have to think he will be better going long. Works are decent and Baffert goes to his first call rider here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 AIR BOSS</u> Cost 105k as he is out of a Mn-bred mare, not something you see every day. Ran 5th of 9 in the debut sprinting. Sadler sticks with the apprentice rider (1 for 3 at the meet for Sadler) on the stretchout. Breeding is long and he will move forward in this one today.</p> <p>A) 6 B) 1,2,3 C) 4,5</p>	<p>3 SANTA ANITA R3 (2:06 PT) 38 CLM 32K, 1M TURF</p> <p>3 BELIEVE INDEED 6-1 6 SUPER PATRIOT 5-2 2 SHEHASTHERITESTUFF 3-1 4 DRIFT AWAY 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 BELIEVE INDEED</u> She's been in the exacta in 17 of 35 on turf and in the money 10 of 18 on the grass at this distance. Clocker report was very high on the most recent work which was bullet drill at 4F. Think the pace will be contested and quick enough for her late run in here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 SHEHASTHERITESTUFF</u> Bejarano is back up after he rode her last time out vs much stronger company. She was off the pace in a race where the early fractions were slow and favored those on the lead. Show finisher won back vs same for Baltas at 10-1. She'll save ground today.</p> <p>A) 2,3,6 B) 1,4 C) 5</p>	<p>4 SANTA ANITA R4 (2:39 PT) 82 MSW 55K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>7 ONE EIGHTY 3-1 3 DUCHAMP 4-1 4 ALWAYS FORGIVEN 8-1 2 ROGALLO 8-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 7 ONE EIGHTY</u> First time starter cost \$300,000 roughly 13 months ago. Has speed bred into the blood on both sides of the tree (Distorted Humor and Speightstown). O'Neill 3 for 11 with first timers in MSW sprint on dirt for this owner. Stayed w/ G1 winner Pavel in a recent drill.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 DUCHAMP</u> Came running on well after a slow start in the debut, the same race where the horse on the rail ran 2nd. Trainer Shirreffs has had a big meet. Dam won 440k for these same connections (won the G1 Santa Margarita in 2005 here going long). Major win player.</p> <p>A) 3,7 B) 2,4 C) 5,6</p>
<p>5 SANTA ANITA R5 (3:12 PT) 45 CLM 40K, 7F DIRT</p> <p>3 SHEER FLATTERY 5-2 4 TOP OF THE GAME 8-1 6 JAN'S RESERVE 2-1 1 VERY VERY STELLA 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 3 SHEER FLATTERY</u> Last time he was at 7F was 7 starts ago and he won at 5-2 with this rider aboard. Didn't run a step in last but he was 30-1 and was not really pressed late. He's a 5x winner at Santa Anita. Can press the pace or roll late from off the pace. Gets a great trip in here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 TOP OF THE GAME</u> Comes out of the same race as the choice and actually beat that one by a few. There were expectations for him as he's been in many grade stakes including one for these new connections. Was off slow 2 back and that cost him better. He had blinkers there.</p> <p>A) 3,4,6 B) 1 C) 2,5</p>	<p>6 SANTA ANITA R6 (3:43 PT) 56 MIZDIRECTION 75K, 5F TURF</p> <p>1 PAINTING CORNERS 5-2 5 GO ON MARY 2-1 4 ALGORHYTHMIC 6-1 3 POSTER GIRL 5-1</p> <p><u>PICK: 1 PAINTING CORNERS</u> Drawing the rail can be a major detriment or a big advantage depending on the style. This one has speed but can also track. She has broken on top in 9 of her 17 starts and 2nd from the gate another 3 times. She has worked strongly. The trip decides her fate.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 ALGORHYTHMIC</u> Talamo went to the lead two back when at 5F. Think she is better suited to come from just behind the pace. Pedroza will settle in at this distance and make a run on the far turn. All 5 of her career wins came here on this turf. Think she'll get a better trip here.</p> <p>A) 1,5 B) 3,4 C) 2</p>	<p>7 SANTA ANITA R7 (4:15 PT) 60 OPT CLM 57K, 6.5F DIRT</p> <p>6 HARD NOT TO LOVE 5-2 4 DEVILS DANCE 5-1 5 UPPERCUT 3-1 2 LADY NINJA 7-2</p> <p><u>PICK: 6 HARD NOT TO LOVE</u> Debut was superb. She was off a step slow but went right up to the lead in big debut. This is a 400k purchase in 2017 and a sib to G1 winner Wonder Gadot. 6F time of 1:09.2 was 1/5 faster than the 6F time in the G2 Santa Monica later in the card (a 7F event).</p> <p><u>VALUE: 4 DEVILS DANCE</u> Despite her win on the grass three back at 5F her breeding is better for the dirt. Fourth place finisher 4 back was Enaya Alrabb who has come back to run 2nd a head in the G1 Starlet and 2nd a half to Bellafina in the G2 Las Virgenes.
