O'Neill having nice meet.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 5 MALIBU MAGIC</u> Late runner will offer some value in here if the pace gets hot. He's only hit the board once but has passed runners in the lane in most of his starts. There were 3 that came back to win from his last start (3rd, 8th and 9th). Interesting D Van Dyke is the main rider for a few of these outfits and was working some here but lands on this one for a trainer he doesn't ride often. Workout reports are high on her workouts.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 10 FABIOLLA</u> She's had 3 races, all in Great Britain, and hit the board in each of them. She finished in front of 29 foes in those 3 starts. Winner of the debut went off favored for Godolphin and picked up a check facing G3. Nice 5th two back behind Coal Front who came back to win in Dubai. Runner he beat in last start had won 4 of 5 coming into that which included 3 stakes. Will get a good trip here.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 1 DR. DORR</u> Baffert cut back in distance in the G2 San Carlos and he finished strongly for 2nd. The winner got loose on the lead and went wire to wire. She was on the rail, a tough spot at 6.5F here, in her last start and she got in tight late. That was a prep for longer and she gets the distance here. Pace quick two and three back. Better trip in this one.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 2 CONFIDENTIALLY</u> Really well-bred filly is making her 3rd start on the grass. She is a nose away from 2 for 2 on the grass. Gets an apprentice rider up for this one and she drops 7 pounds for the addition of that rider. Seems to be better without blinkers. She won three back with a late surge at 5-2 odds. Moved a bit early two back and was tagged on the wire. Was getting to the winner in last. Decent work since last start.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 7 CRACKLING BREAD</u> Finally got through for a win after 16 starts in her last out. She had blinkers added two back and that seemed to have been what has moved her forward. Won with Bejarano aboard for the first time and he is back in this. Has tactical speed. She ran a strong 3rd to Vasilika last out. That winner has won 13 of 15 starts, 6 graded stakes including a G1. Late charge.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 3 PETER'S KITTEN</u> She ran well in four of her 6 starts. Might've been sent too hard from the inside in start three back and she tired at KEE. Broke out of the widest 10 post two back. Won in her first start for Sadler who is having a huge year so far. Prat aboard. Three winners went off at odds of 25-1, 8-1 and 3-1. The one who was 2nd was Friday and was coming off 16 month break and was dropping from MSW.</p> <p><u>VALUE: 8 SENDITLIKECHILLY</u> 4YO was an 85k purchase back in 2017. He comes in here as a first time gelding and is protected from the claim as he returns at a higher tag than he was last in before the break. No luck in the post draws in last two starts.
