Good trip.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 SNAZZY DRESSER He's going to be the speed of the speed in here and that is dangerous with this small field. Sent legitimate fractions in the win in last start and that was the 1st with blinkers on since last October. Could be tough if he's allowed to relax early. Clockers high on her workouts.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 TILTED TOWERS Has a few of big runners in the female tree. 1983 Wood Memorial winner (and multiple G1 winner) Bounding Basque and 1985 G2 Withers winner El Basco are deeper in this pedigree. Worked well per the clockers last couple of drills. Gets the rail here and will save ground. Late runner will need the pace to be hot early. Comes flying.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 UNBRIDLED ETHOS He made an early move to the leaders last out in the common race run on May 5th here when off at 11-1. Overlay again.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 LADY PRANCELOT The extra distance might help her more in here than anyone else. Made her usual late move in last and was game when 2nd to the morning line favorite in here. 4 for 5 in the money on this turf course. Talamo been up in many of her best races. Smith back up today.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 LA FORCE She was left in the wake of the huge effort by the top choice in last but was 2nd and 5 clear of 3rd. Did beat that one last summer in the G1 Beholder Mile but it appears the top choice is a better runner right now than at that time. She tired late to run 5th at 11-1. The runner-up came back to win in MSW company. Bred well for grass. These connections win a lot of races and are not afraid to drop in class. Excellent workouts.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 CHERISHED Was in the same race as Jaccat and ran 4th beaten 3 (about a length and a half behind that one). Might have bled in there as she is getting Lasix for the first time today. Much improved run on the grass and the blood is there for turf. Works have been above average for Cassidy. The breeding is pretty solid for this homebred. Dam was a G3 winner on turf in Europe for this owner.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 MUSIC TO MY EARS Nice run on the grass last out when 2nd at odds of 5-1. He beat 7 runners in there with Gryder up for the first time. Only runner to have run back from that race was the one who was 6th beaten 5. He ran second on the class drop to 50k.
