<p>1 SANTA ANITA (1:00 PT) 72 MSW 65K, 5F TURF</p> <p>2 DEUCE 5-2 1 CAMBY 3-1 5 SNAPPISH 7-2 7 MO FORZA 7-2</p> <p>PICK: 2 DEUCE Good debut on the dirt here at 32-1. He got away best and sat nicely in 3rd and held that position throughout (9 clear of 4th). His dam won 150k (3 for 4 on turf). Full sib, Candura, won her debut (a 5F turf race at DMR). High grade from clockers for the 5/28 work here.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 CAMBY Makes his first start since September when he was dead last at 9-2 odds on the dirt. He ran well enough in most of his other starts including a runner-up finish to Triple Crown winner Justify. EIDSON 5-1 1 VERIFIED 5-1</p> <p>PICK: 7 PREACHER Hollendorfer is 5 for 16 (31%) with a 2YO 1st time starter on dirt at 4.5F to 5F here at SA in the month of June. Win early breeding in the pedigree. Dam sire is Songandaprayer, known for precocity. Dam is a half to the '98 BC Sprint winner, Artax. He's working super.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 THANKS MR. EIDSON First time starter for trainer Jeff Bonde. He sold for 210K last September which is 2 ½ times the sire fee. Bonde can win with 2YO debut types (already had one this meet). He normally works them like this. Hasn't won a race since his debut and only twice in top 2 in his career. Faced better in most of those starts. Key race 3 back. 6 of the 7 who have run back have run in the exacta (3 winners). 2nd dam is the \$4M, 11-time G1 winner Azeri.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 BUCKSTOPPER KIT Won a 40k four back (Desormeaux aboard) and is actually two for three with Kent has been up. Will get a nice trip saving ground from the inside post. Will need someone to go out with the outside runner to keep the pace fair. Notice it was over 5 back to third. While the time was fast, it came on a glib surface. Best 2YO first start for this trainer (small sample size) in 5 years. 12x sprint winner is in female tree.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 PAS DE PANIQUE First time starter by a sire known for having speed in the blood. Trainer has had 4 firster 2YO's on the dirt here at Santa Anita in the last 5 years. While he didn't win any, he was 4th twice, 3rd once and 2nd once, finished in front of most of the field. <p>5 SANTA ANITA (3:03 PT) 66 CINEMA 150K, 1M 1/8 TURF</p> <p>5 KING OF SPEED 4-1 6 NEPTUNE'S STORM 7-5 3 RIJEKA 8-1 2 GREGORIAN CHANT 2-1</p> <p>PICK: 5 KING OF SPEED Sure was very good in back to back stakes as a two-year old. He won both coming from far back to win going away at 15-1 and 5-1 odds. Can excuse the next three as he was in the G1 BC Jv Turf, G1 Los Al Fut on dirt and El Camino on synthetic. OK 4th in last start.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 RIJEKA He's been solely a miler in his career and is 2 for 8 in the US. Not sure Baltas loved the ride that Desormeaux gave him from the 1 post in last and he moves to a new rider in here. Other than that, he's been in top 3 on firm turf. Obviously last can be overlooked as he was even money and eased in. Comes back as a gelding and has a stream of very nice drills. Winner two back won in an opt cl next. 3-time runner-up looks long overdue.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 STREET CLASS Really like all three starts. Was on the rail in each of them and that isn't easy for a 2YO. Blinkers added in last and was beaten just a neck for second. Runner-up came back to win MSW. They have tried everything to wake this filly up. Sprint, route, dirt, turf, blinkers, bug riders to drop weight. Apparently worked very well in 5/27 drill. Better post draw than normal.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 BELLIZE Other Sadler runner and other Espinoza up in the irons. This is a first timer with serious turf pedigree. Sibs Keri Belle (4 for 15, 287k and G3 winner on grass) and Guggenheim (115k on grass) were turf runners. She's got some nice works on dirt.
