She won 864k on grass in her career. This English Channel filly has been off slow in 3 of her 5 starts. Beaten 2 in G3 two back. Runner-up won G3 Seniorita next. Top 2 out of last ran 3<sup>rd</sup> in stakes next.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 SPACE TALK</p> <p>Hasn't run a bad race after her debut. Only time off the board in that span was last out when she ran 4<sup>th</sup> beaten just over a length at 5-1. Was only 4 behind Vailika 3 back. Will be moving best late if pace is hot early. 5th and 6th three back won next (stakes, op cl).</p> <p>A) 1,2,7 B) 4,6 C) 3,5</p>	<p>4 SANTA ANITA (2:34 PT) 82 MDN CLM 50K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>4 BABY GRONK 4-5 7 JEN GO UNCHAINED 7-2 1 PIG IRON 3-1 5 CALDER VALE 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 4 BABY GRONK</p> <p>Ran second three straight after the claim for 50k out of the debut. Not thrilled with a beaten favorite in 4 of 5 career starts but is dropping to the right level for this. Willing to look past the turf run last out as he may not want turf. Connections do place them well.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 JEN GO UNCHAINED</p> <p>He was close in both of his starts when with MSW company. 4<sup>th</sup> beaten just 4 at 57-1 first time out. Got away a step slow in last but he got up for 5<sup>th</sup> beaten less than 4 on the turf. He's worked three times since his last start for Puype. The other as such for his wife won at 30k level in 2015. Winner of last start ran 2<sup>nd</sup> at 11-1 in opt clm 50k next.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 CLOCHARD STREET</p> <p>Takes the biggest class drop in racing here as she was in MSW company in first two and now faces a very weak maiden claimer. She broke from the 10 post in last and was wide on the first turn. Was first start in blinkers. Clockers liked her most recent drill on 6/2.</p> <p>A) 3,5,7 B) 2 C) 1,4,6</p>

She took the Group 1 Dubai Duty Free and finished her career winning the G3 Locust Grove at CD. Upset winner in debut at LRC in a decent race for a MSW there. He has been working well. Is bred for the grass.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 LEGENDS OF WAR</p> <p>4<sup>th</sup> in the CD 125k William Walker was prior undefeated Pletcher runner, Bulletin, who won the 920k BC Juv Turf Sprint at CD on the BC undercard. Faced much better in Europe before this year. He is 2 for 2 going MSW to this md clm 30k level. One of those winners, as this one is doing, went turf to dirt in the 2<sup>nd</sup> start and blinkers on. Was off slow in debut but passed some runners late. Nice work back.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 ROYALLY BLAND</p> <p>Debut was against much better company. The winner was 4<sup>th</sup> in the G1 Acorn Saturday and 2 behind the Ky Oaks winner for 2<sup>nd</sup> at 4-1. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> all came right back to win in their next starts. Van Dyke has a 26% strike rate for McCarthy. Her offspring includes 1.8M grass winner Imagining (won the '14 Man O'War). Winner of debut a stakes winner. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> won next starts in MSW. Slightly outworked by the 500k winner, Caribou Club, on 5/27.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 TAYLOR AND BURTON</p> <p>Off slow as the 2-1 favorite in her first time out. She hasn't been seen since then which is coming up on two years. Trainer is 4 for 8 (50%) with 6 in the exacta (75%) with a long layoff type like this one for this ownership. Good works at LRC.
