

ON THIS DATE (1998) – THATSUSINTHEOLBEAN trained by Doug Oliver and owned by Nadine Andreas won 18 of 77 starts for nearly half a million dollars. He was a 14-time stakes winner (6 at Canterbury Park). On June 20, 1998, he won the \$50,000 John Bullit Stakes over Shades of Silver and Rookie's Turn. The time for 1M 1/16 on turf was a speedy 1:43.2.

Repeat of last might be enough to win in here.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 SURELY A LEGEND</b><br/>She was dropping in from MSW to the same race on June 2<sup>nd</sup> that two others are out of. She should have been more competitive but finished last. Trainer is 2 for 11 at the meet. Rider was up in last and is back up here. Something went wrong in the race last out at Churchill. She was 5-2 but beat just one runner home and was a voided vet scratch after. Top trainer Diodoro here. Rider is hitting at 32% this year when he is riding for Diodoro.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 5 CAESAR'S CALPURNIA</b><br/>First time starter for a trainer who had just 6 wins in 185 starts before last earlier this month. She won 2 of her past 3 starts at odds of 13-1 and 16-1. Both of those winners were with Negron up. This filly has a few decent drills. Will be very tough today.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 EMERALDS R US</b><br/>Banking on the turf MSW race that the top choice is out of is a strong race. This runner was in the same race. Mn-bred is much better on turf.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 7 P CLUB</b><br/>He's been primarily a 5F sprinter on the turf but last win came at 7.5F on the turf at TUP about 26 months ago (at 20-1 odds). Key race 2 back. 4<sup>th</sup> (Giant Gamble) and 5<sup>th</sup> (Buckys Pick) both won back beating many in here. **PICK: 5 CLICKBAIT**

Comes off a superb win in the Mn-bred Lady Slipper stakes. Thought she moved early into a fast pace in there but was so much the best it didn't matter. She might be able to relax a bit early with other speedy types in here. 5YO mare is sitting on a big year here.

**VALUE: 6 LADY GOLDSTART**

Interesting new face for top connections. Comes in off an easy win here in the mud. Filly she beat in 1<sup>st</sup> start (Decade) won a CD MSW next and took 100k opt clm at OP by 3 (87 Beyer). Stumble 2 back. Tough spot at KD on turf 3 back. Dam was a G3 winner. Playable.

**PICK: 1 DEUCE**

Diodoro is 10 for 28 (36%), 15 in top three (54%) with a new acquisition shipping from Southern Cal to Canterbury. It's a bit of a guessing game. He's won 3 of his last 4 with a new runner to his barn here and all were at 16k clm. Faced much better at SA recently.

**VALUE: 4 RIDING THE TRAIN**

He's sprinted on the turf 5 times. Off the board in 2 of those (debut when he broke in a tangle and 3 back off a layoff). Pushed out in mid-stretch by the winner in last but wasn't getting to the top two anyway. He looks like a good use under in the exotics in this one.
