Robertino Diodoro started 4 runners at TUP in maiden opt claiming that went off at 5-1 or less. He won 3 of them and was second in the other. Dam won her debut by 5 at Santa Anita for the same team. A sib, Take Charge Tom, is 6 for 10 and won her debut by 9 at this level here a year ago at 6-5 odds with Mojica and he has won 5 stakes races since.

**VALUE: 6 INDEPENDENCE RISE**

This is the other Diodoro in the race. He has fairly modest bloodlines but sold for a decent 82k this year at a sale. He has been working heads up with the top choice so check the betting to see where the money ends up. Diodoro bets so he will tip his hand at the window. Diodoro has started this meet on fire (19 of 37 in the top two). Obvious player.

She caught a pretty strong race at Canterbury Park in her most recent start. That came back in June, however, not a great thing for a low level claimer. The top 4 finishers out of that race came back to win. Another (5<sup>th</sup>) won for the 1<sup>st</sup> time two starts later. She hit the board in both of her starts at TUP at this level. The layoff and low % rider are concerns.

**VALUE: 8 BRASCIA'S ART**

She was under 5-1 in the first start. She broke dead last in there and was erratic early in the race. Once she started to make a run, she was 6-wide. Despite all of that, she made up good ground to get within a length in the end. The time was not fast (11 Beyer) but the winner did come back and win a 6k at 7-1 with a 37 Beyer (more in line with prior figs).

7YO gelding was middle of the pack without threatening in a similar spot last time out. He was well-beaten as the even money favorite but that might have been a decent group for the level. The winner came back to beat str allw foes. Best racing days are likely behind him but has a high percentage trainer, Diodoro, in his corner. Late run coming.

**VALUE: 4 ANNA'S IRON MAN**

He deserves a bit of credit running against the ideal flow in the last start. They went :46.3 for the half and this one was pressing that fast pace. The other speed (9-2 off odds) ran 9<sup>th</sup> beaten a distance. No help with the post draws the two starts prior. Did not have Lasix in the last start but it's back in the fold here. Might outrun the expected big odds.

**PICK: 4 LEMON MERINGUE**

This race is restricted to those who haven't won since 9/27. This one gets into the race as a last time winner on 9/3. He has 4 wins and 9 in the money from his last 10 dirt sprints on a fast track. This is a major class drop. This trainer has 7 wins in 14 starts at the meet. This one is 6 for 11 in top 2 at the distance. Likely comes from off the pace in this spot.

**VALUE: 9 ALWAYS ON CAY**

Claimed for 5k at EMD 8 starts ago. He's won 3 of the next 7 for the new connections. That includes a strong win in a relatively weak opt clm last time out at 2-5 odds. He was too close to a fast pace two back and tired. This rider has been aboard in 5 of his starts and producing 3 wins. He is entered in an allowance on Tue. If he goes here he'll be tough.

Robertino Diodoro is 6 for 10 (60%) with 9 in the top two (90%) with a RP shipper into Turf Paradise and running at low level claiming. Overall, he's 58 for 182 (32%) for this owner at Turf Paradise when 3-1 or less. Hasn't run since October and laid off after an awful race (and drops to the lowest level). Those are worrisome but he wins if he's right.

**VALUE: 6 SUPER ANNIE**

Sweetwater Fair shipper was allowed to get away at nearly 22-1 in the first local start this year. She ran big when she closed resolutely to get third. She went from 13 back when they hit the halfway mark to finish just over a length back in the end. The races at SWF and WYO were a bit better but a drop to this level on the circuit move made some sense.

**PICK: 2 STREET HUMOR**

In the last 5 months, this trainer is 15 for 37 (41%) with 23 in the money (62%) and a positive \$2.61 ROI. He is 7 for 14 here at TUP in that timespan (50%). He came back off the 3.5 month layoff and ran a winning race when beaten just a head. The winner of that race returned to upset in a win in a str allow at 5-1 (71 Beyer). 7 for 14 in the exacta at TUP.

**VALUE: 5 NAVAL ESCORT**

Prior to the last two starts he had only been at under 15k claiming once. That was the race he was claimed out of 5 back at EMD when in for 8k. The last two were on the turf so they can be overlooked since he had not run on turf in any of his previous 32 starts. Hit the board in 15 of 30 dirt starts. A deep closer but has some backclass to beat these.
