
BELMONT STAKES PAST PERFORMANCES

1 ½ MILES. (2.24) 124th Running THE BELMONT STAKES (Grade I). Purse \$500,000 added. 3-year-olds. Scale Weight. \$5,000 to pass the entry box; \$5,000 to start with \$500,000 added. At any time prior to Closing, Thursday, June 4, 1992, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$50,000 to The New York Racing Association Inc. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 12% to third and 6% to fourth. Colts and Geldings, 126 lbs.; Fillies, 121 lbs. Starters to be named at the closing time of entries. The Belmont field will be limited to sixteen (16) starters. In the event that more than 16 entries pass through the entry box at the closing, the starters will be determined at the closing with 50% of the field (8 starters) given preference by accumulating the highest earnings in Graded Stakes (lifetime), including all money paid for performances in such Graded Stakes. The next five (5) starters (approximate 30%) will be determined by accumulating the highest earnings (lifetime) in all races except restricted races (i.e., any stake containing eligibility conditions other than sex and age). The remaining 3 starters (approximate 20%) shall be determined by accumulating the highest earnings (lifetime) in all races. Should this preference produce any ties the additional starter(s) shall be determined by lot. If the rules described result in the exclusion of any horse, the \$5,000 entry fee will be refunded to the owner of said horse. The winning owner will be presented with the August Belmont Memorial Cup, to be retained for one year, as well as a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Nominations to each and all of the Triple Crown races, The Kentucky Derby, The Preakness and The Belmont (the "Races") may be made only by payment of a single subscription fee to Triple Crown Productions, Inc., as agent for Churchill Downs Incorporated, The Maryland Jockey Club and the New York Racing Association Inc. (the "Associations"). The subscription fee for 389 nominations received by January 18, 1992, is \$600 and for 18 nominations received by April 1, 1992, is \$4,500. (These fees are to be apportioned equally among the three Associations to be part of the total purse for each of the three races.) After April 1, at any time prior to Closing for the Kentucky Derby, additional nominations to all three races will be accepted and the nominee will be eligible for the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge bonus, upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$150,000 to Churchill Downs Incorporated. Following the running of The Kentucky Derby, but at any time prior to Closing for the Preakness Stakes, horses may be nominated to the remaining Races but

will not be eligible for the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge bonus, upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$100,000 to The Maryland Jockey Club of Baltimore City, Inc. At any time prior to the Closing for the Belmont Stakes, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$50,000 to the New York Racing Association Inc. All supplemental fees will be included in the purse distribution of the respective Races for which paid. Horses nominated by payment of supplementary fee ("supplemental nominees") will not be allowed to enter any Race in which the maximum number of starters has otherwise been reached prior to the time of Closing. If the number of supplemental nominees exceed the number of available starting positions at Closing, the conditions of each respective Race shall be applied to determine which supplemental nominees will be allowed to start in such Race. All nominees, supplemental or otherwise, will be requested to pay entry and starting fees for the Race or Races to which they have been nominated. Triple Crown Productions, Inc. is guaranteeing total earnings of \$5,000,000 to the owner of any horse which wins all of the 1992 Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stakes and Belmont Stakes races (the "Races") and is offering a \$1,000,000 bonus to the owner of a horse with the best, most consistent finishes in the Races. The "Triple Crown Challenge" monies will be paid to the owner of a horse which meets these criteria: 1. Finishes in all three Triple Crown Races as listed above; 2. Earns points by finishing first, second, third or fourth in at least one of the Triple Crown Races: and 3. Earns the highest number of points over the course of the three Races. Points are assigned for each race: Win-10, Place-5, Show-3, Fourth-1. In the event of a tie, the \$1 million bonus will be distributed equally among the top point-getters. In the event of a dead-heat, equal points will be awarded in full. For example, 10 points for each horse in a dead-heat to win. Triple Crown Productions Inc. will pay to the owner of a horse winning all of the Races that amount necessary to bring total earnings for the Triple Crown winner to \$5,000,000. The total will include the winner's purse distributed by each racing association; the \$1 million point bonus described above; and a further bonus guaranteed by Triple Crown Productions to reach the \$5 million total. Triple Crown Productions will present the Triple Crown Trophy to the owner of a horse that sweeps the Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stakes and Belmont Stakes. Closed with 1 Supplemental Nominee: My Memoirs-GB.

A funny thing happened to PINE BLUFF on the way to the Preakness

... He grew up. Consider that Pine Bluff didn't start competing effectively in stakes races until his connections came to the realization that the colt would only put forth his best effort when allowed to run freely and closeup to the early

pace. Using those tactics. Pine Bluff was unbeatable at distances over one (excluding the Breeders' Cup Juvenile and the Kentucky Derby, run over a surface he doesn't seem to respond on), winning Remsen, Nashua, Rebel and Arkansas Derby.

In the Preakness, however, Pine Bluff was caught in close quarters coming away from the gate and found himself sixth, nearly eight lengths from the leader down the backstretch. Instead of rushing up prematurely or losing interest altogether, he proceeded to gain in position and in lengths at each subsequent point of call, and was drawing away in the final yards from Alydeed, a quality colt who had settled into upper stretch with a commanding lead.

A.P. INDY has not been beaten since his career debut at six furlongs, and the \$2.9 million yearlings, who is a half-brother to superior slop horse Summer Squall, has the pedigree to handle 12 furlongs...or slop...or just about anything he's asked to do. In the Belmont, he is asked to duplicate or improve upon his

1-A.P. Indy 2-Cristofori 3-Pine Bluff Longshot-Agincourt

It takes speed and class to win the Belmont, and since his maiden win last fall, A.P. INDY has been a study in both. The son of Seattle Slew has a tractable running style which gives Eddie Delahoussaye the option to place him wherever appropriate, and the \$2.9 million yearling has demonstrated his class by winning six straight.

A.P. Indy can lay off the speed or go to the front, and his pedigree suggests he'll have no difficulty with the mile and a half trip. But what makes the colt even more of a dominating presence in this year's Belmont is his current condition. He enters the race as a fresh horse, having raced only once since the Santa Anita Derby. He comes off a scintillating win in the Peter Pan, in which he finished as powerfully as he did in his best previous race -the San Rafael Stakes on February 29 at Santa Anita.

With as many handicapping factors as he has in his favor-speed, class, a conditioning edge and a solid race over the track—A.P. Indy is nothing short of a mortal lock to demonstrate his superiority over a moderate crop of 3year-olds.

CRISTOFORI is an interesting longshot who ships in from France. The colt's pedigree (by Fappiano) and running style (speed) suggests he should be more comfortable racing on dirt, and the critical element of early speed cannot be overemphasized. While he tired in his most recent start at Longchamp, that race is likely to have done the colt a world of good. Horses moving from turf to dirt often hold a solid edge in conditioning, and Cristofori will be on or near the pace throughout the contest. He's a token bet to win, but a solid play to complete the exacta with the best horse in the line-up.

PINE BLUFF was a gritty winner of the Preakness, but the colt's laterunning style isn't always conducive to the manner in which the Belmont is generally run—with a slow early pace. Pine Bluff is a consistent, workmanlike son of Danzig who will run his race. The question is whether his best is good enough under circumstances that figure to compromise the chances of a come-from-behinder.

AGINCOURT looms an interesting longshot candidate to finish in the money, as Belmont is his favorite racetrack. CASUAL LIES will be plodding around the track in his quest for the \$1 million bonus, but he has yet to display the brilliance normally associated with a classic winner.

were shipping out, some to Pimlico for the Preakness, Drysdale remained at Churchill Downs, working on A. P. Indy's foot.

"Being it was a blind quarter crack (it can't be seen), we had to try to pin-point the area that was affected," he said. "After we accomplished that we went ahead and equipped him with bar shoes and put on a fiberglass quarter crack patch, which helped alleviate the condition. If he had put in a scintillating work, who knows, he might have been able to make the Preakness, but I just didn't feel the foot had stabilized enough to run him. I feel the fiberglass patch has made a big difference."

Drysdale switched back to conventional shoes and ran him in the Peter Pan Stakes at Belmont Park. After running fifth early, A. P. Indy made a big move around the far turn to take the lead. Colony Light, another horse coming off a layoff, quickly moved up from last place to challenge A. P. Indy for the lead. But when Eddie Delahoussaye asked the son of Seattle Slew to run, he responded by drawing off to a five and a half lengths victory in the fast time of 1:47 2/5 for the mile and an eighth.

"At first I felt the move was a little premature but I think he might have been a little fresh," Drysdale said with a laugh. "Delahoussaye said the horse wanted to go, and being he was moving so easily he just let him go."

Drysdale has taken every step to get A. P. Indy in top shape and ready for the Belmont. Is there anything left?

"Keep our fingers crossed and just see how we do," he said.

performance in the Peter Pan stakes on May 24—his first start since sustaining a quarter-crack on the eve of the Derby.

CASUAL LIES steadied turning into the backstretch when beaten two lenghths by A.P. Indy in the Santa Anita Derby, and along with Pine Bluff, he may have a conditioning edge over that rival after solid efforts back to back in the Derby and Preakness. At Pimlico, Casual Lies moved strongly leaving the far turn, but then angled over to the rail (which was the deepest path of the drying out surface) and continued on determinedly.

AL SABIN certainly has the pedigree to handle the Belmont distance, as he is out of Sabin, a multiple stakes-winning mare at 12 furlongs in the 1980s.

Although talent a question, My Memoirs on upswing

LONDON, England — My Memoirs went on a round-trip of 150 miles as part of his preparation for Saturday's Belmont Stakes when he worked at Lingfield Park racecourse late last week.

"We wanted him to go round the turns and he did it well; he went about a mile," said the colt's trainer, Richard Hannon, whose third U.S. runner My Memoirs will be.

As far as staying a mile and a half is concerned, Hannon "sees no reason why not; he was finishing like a train over a mile and a quarter when he won the Dee (the listed race My Memoirs won at Chester last time)."

Hannon, whose two previous U.S. runners (Only Yours and Showbrook in Kentucky last fall), had almost everything go wrong with them—one was 44 hours in transit and the other was partly blind when his goggles slipped—makes the journey to Belmont Park for what will be the last race My Memoirs runs for his stable.


After the race My Memoirs will stay in the United States, though his new owners, Team Valor Stable and agent Andy Smith, who handled the deal on their behalf, have not yet decided who will be the colt's trainer.

My Memoirs is a tough, consistent and hard-working colt though it has to be said that nothing he has achieved so far has put one in mind of a classic level contender in this country and he was not considered worthy of entry for the Derbys in Rome or Hamburg, let alone at Epsom.

That to an extent can be counterbalanced by saying that he appears to be on the upgrade and that his form is advancing as he goes over longer distances, but even so things are put into some sort of proportion by the fact that he was rated 44 pounds behind Arazi by Timeform last year and did not get a mark on this in the international classifications.

He is a son of the dual 2,000 Guineas winner Don't Forget Me, who was also trained by Hannon in the Wiltshire village of Fast Everleigh, and his first

venture into public life represented something of a loss for one of the British Isles' ace pin-hookers, Timmy Hyde of the Camas Park Stud in Ireland. Hyde paid \$49,500 for the colt as a foal but received only just over half that when he was re-sold as a yearling.

My Memoirs ran five times as a 2-year-old. Like every horse that leaves Hannon's yard to go racing, he knew his job from flagfall and made a winning debut in a run-of-the-mill race at Chepstow at the end of June. He moved up from six to seven furlongs next time and did well to upset the odds-on Alhijaz at York, getting two pounds and winning by half a length.

The colt did not win in three other starts last year, but he ran well in defeat, particularly when just failing to confirm York form with Alhijaz (beaten a head on five-pound worse terms) at Lingfield. He also showed good pace behind Dr Devious at Goodwood and in the Tattersalls race at Newmarket won by Derby contender.

Hannon says that he is a horse who likes being up with the pace from the start—Don't Forget Me had the same characteristic—and that My Memoirs was a bit unlucky when only third at Doncaster first time out this year.

The colt then moved up from seven furlongs to a mile and finished fourth, though a decisively beaten fourth, to the subsequent Predominate Stakes winner Jeune at Thirsk. Last time he went farther up in distance, to a mile and a quarter for the Dee Stakes at Chester. He found the ultra-tight track easy to handle, producing a strong run in the short straight to get up to snatch the listed prize by a short head from Profusion, who was receiving four pounds. Torrey Canyon, favorite and third at Chester after pulling too hard, went on to beat the 2,000 Guineas third Pursuit of Love at Kempton Park two weeks ago though it is probably unwise to take those two comparative bits of form too literally.
