Will like the cut to 6.5F here.	PICK: 6 TALIESIN Rattled off three wins in a row before she was 4 th in the last start in the 200k stakes. That was a good 4 th . That field was 13 deep so she beat 9 runners at 7-1 odds. Is well-spotted on the drop back to optional claiming for this one. She is 2 for 2 at the distance. Pennington has been aboard for the most part and is back aboard here.	He was certainly good in the first US start when he was able to overcome a poor break and beat a good Sar allw field at nearly 9-1 odds. Notice the distance from 2 nd to		
VALUE: 7 EDGE OF TOWN Shipper from Delaware Park. She won a strong 50k opt claimer on this track 4 starts ago. Good effort at 6-1 in the start two back when she hung in from the place at 6-1. The third place finisher from that race came back to win at the same level. 4th came back to win in an alw at Penn National next. Will position a prime spot early.	VALUE: 4 BIG AIR Moved to supertrainer Jamie Ness and this one fired a career best 78 Beyer. She was facing cheaper and did move to the main track but Ness has a history of big move ups when he takes over. In addition, he normally keeps them in top form start over start. Gets tested in here for class. Don't think she needs the lead to win this.	VALUE: 2 DOUBLE YOUR MONEY Has some speed and that could put him right off the flank of the rail runner. Great record here at Parx with 8 exacta finishes in his 9 starts here. Rider was up for the win three back and the runner-up last time out. He normally takes money and runs to it at the lower level conditions. Trainer is 1 for 1. He won for same ownership.

VALUE: 7 CARMELINA Very consistent mare. She's won 3 of her last 4 starts and beat some of these in the process. Comes into this off a career best Beyer figure of 95. Didn't appear she wanted any part of the track in the Grade 2 race two starts ago. Paco Lopez is 3 for 3 when riding her and is back up today. Has speed but can rate if she needs to.	VALUE: 4 DILGER Strong third in the Grade 2 Carter 4 back. Was a 3-2 fav in the next start and faded to last. Something clearly was off there as he hit the bench for over 2.5 months. Has two good starts on the comeback at Saratoga and earned high Beyers in both of those. Can't hurt to have Irad Ortiz back. Should sit midpack in a very good spot.	VALUE: 7 MAD HOUSE Hard to know how good this one is. He rattled off three straight wins at Canterbury Park but the competition in those races was significantly lower. He did pass the eye test and the connections obviously think he'll be able to compete at this level. Was runner-up to a Brad Cox firster in the debut who won the Sam F Davis next.

The only subpar effort for this filly came two back in a G1 on a sloppy track at Saratoga. She obviously didn't want that surface as she beat just one runner in there at 1-5 odds. The winner of last is a \$1.5M winner who is 4x G1 placed in her career. She's a serious racehorse in her own right. This superstar is 5 for 5 at the distance.

VALUE: 8 DRY POWDER

She resume looks amazing if you discount the CCA G1 two back when she hit the gate and never fired. Was a 9-1 runner-up in her second start when runner-up at AQU in front of morning line favorite, Scottish Lassie. Beat 12 foes in the prep for this. She drew the 11 post in there, stalked the pace and widened in the lane at 7-1.

What would his resume look like had Sovereignty and Journalism not been in his races. Never been off of the board on the dirt and has been G1 placed all 3 times he was in those races. Legendary breeding as the dam of this one produced both Mage and Dornoch. Notice the distance clear of third in the Grade 2 Jim Dandy last out.

VALUE: 10 MO PLEX

Beat a talented Chunk of Gold in the Ohio Derby. That one came back to romp in the G3 West Virginia Derby at Mountaineer. NY-bred is G1 placed and has earned north of three-quarters of a million dollars. Brings the winning rider from the Ohio Derby in here. Love how he rated kindly for him in that win. Stumbled start in last.

Ran 2nd to the razor sharp Roll On Big Joe. 1st and 3rd from that race 4 back won G3's next. Toss the turf start. Added blinkers in the last start and ran well. Pretty big rider move here.

VALUE: 5 MAXIMUS MERIDIUS

Don't think the last start was his true talent. He was a sharp winner two back despite a stumble at the start. He was in the exacta in 7 of 11 starts last year and has won 4 of 8 on this track. Beat Full Moon Madness in a couple of stakes at Aqueduct. Handled races without Lasix quite well. Rider won 3 of the 6 starts he was up.
