

BELMONT STAKES PAST PERFORMANCES

1 1/2 MILES. (2.24) 125th Running THE BELMONT STAKES (Grade I). Purse \$500,000 added. 3-year-olds. Scale Weight. \$5,000 to pass the entry box; \$5,000 to start with \$500,000 added. At any time prior to closing, Thursday, June 3, 1993, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$50,000 to The New York Racing Association Inc. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 12% to third and 6% to fourth. Colts and Geldings, 126 lbs.; Fillies, 121 lbs. Starters to be named at the closing time of entries. The Belmont field will be limited to sixteen (16) starters. In the event that more than 16 entries pass through the entry box at the closing, the starters will be determined at the closing with 50% of the field (8 starters) given preference by accumulating the highest earnings in Graded Stakes (lifetime), including all money paid for performances in such Graded Stakes. The next five (5) starters (approximate 30%) will be determined by accumulating the highest earnings (lifetime) in all races except restricted races (i.e., any stake containing eligibility conditions other than sex and age). The remaining 3 starters (approximate 20%) shall be determined by accumulating the highest earnings (lifetime) in all races. Should this preference produce any ties the additional starter(s) shall be determined by lot. If the rules described result in the exclusion of any horse, the \$5,000 entry fee will be refunded to the owner of said horse. The winning owner will be presented with the August Belmont Memorial Cup, to be retained for one year, as well as a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Nominations to each of all of the Triple Crown races, The Kentucky Derby, The Preakness and The Belmont (the "Races") may be made only by payment of a single subscription fee to Triple Crown Productions, Inc., as agent for Churchill Downs Incorporated, The Maryland Jockey Club and the New York Racing Association Inc. (the "Associations"). The subscription fee for 342 nominations received by January 16, 1993 is \$600 and for 25 nominations received by March 27, 1993, is \$4,500. (These fees are to be apportioned equally among the three Associations to be part of the total purse for each of the three races.) At any prior time to closing for the Kentucky Derby, additional nominations to all three races will be accepted and the nominee will be eligible for the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge bonus, upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$150,000 to Churchill Downs Incorporated. Following the running of The Kentucky Derby, but at any time prior to closing

for the Preakness Stakes, horses may be nominated to the remaining races but will not be eligible for the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge bonus, upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$100,000 to The Maryland Jockey Club of Baltimore City, Inc. At any time prior to the closing for the Belmont Stakes, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$50,000 to the New York Racing Association Inc. All supplemental fees will be included in the purse distribution of the respective Races for which paid. Horses nominated by payment of supplementary fee ("supplemental nominees") will not be allowed to enter any race in which the maximum number of starters has otherwise been reached prior to the time of closing. If the number of supplemental nominees exceed the number of available starting positions at closing, the conditions of each respective race shall be applied to determine which supplemental nominees will be allowed to start in such race. All nominees will be allowed to start in such race. All nominees, supplemental or otherwise, will be requested to pay entry and starting fees for the race or races to which they have been nominated. Triple Crown Productions, Inc. is guaranteeing total earnings of \$5,000,000 to the owner of any horse which wins all of the 1993 Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stake and Belmont Stakes races (the "Races") and is offering a \$1,000,000 bonus to the owner of a horse with the best, most consistent finishes in the Races. The "Triple Crown Challenge" monies will be paid to the owner of a horse which meets these criteria: 1. Finishes in all three Triple Crown Races as listed above; 2. Earns points by finishing first, second, third or fourth in at least one of the Triple Crown Races; and 3. Earns the highest number of points over the course of the three Races. Points are assigned for each race: Win-10, Place-5, Show-3, Fourth-1. In the event of a tie, the \$1 million bonus will be distributed equally among the top point-getters. In the event of a dead-heat, equal points will be awarded in full. For example, 10 points for each horse in a dead-heat to win. Triple Crown Productions Inc. will pay to the owner of a horse winning all of the Races that amount necessary to bring total earnings for the Triple Crown winner to \$5,000,000. The total will include the winner's purse distributed by each racing association; the \$1 million point bonus described above; and a further bonus guaranteed by Triple Crown Productions to reach the \$5 million total. Triple Crown Productions will present the Triple Crown Trophy to the owner of a horse that sweeps the Kentucky Derby, Preakness Stakes and Belmont Stakes.

A CLOSER LOOK

CHEROKEE RUN

Has won more often than any horse in field, but question remains whether one two-turn race this year is enough to get a mile and a half here. Antley, who just missed winning '91 Belmont with Stike the Gold, picks up mount from suspended Day. Likes a wet track, and he shouldn't get cooked early, given the light dose of speed in field. There's a lot to like here folks.

VIRGINIA RAPIDS

This year's "wise guy" horse, and these types rarely win. This could be the exception, however. His 109 Beyer in the Peter Pan surpasses anything put up by any 3-year-old this year, and you never want to go up against Jerkens at showtime. If you like him, note that A.P. Indy, Danzig Connection and Coastal did the Peter Pan-Belmont double; if you don't, you must be overjoyed that he is picking up 12 pounds and that he's never been farther than nine furlongs. We like him.

KISSIN KRIS

Would've like to have seen a race since the Derby, but can't deny the fact that this horse is always closing. Race at Churchill Downs was better than it looks on paper. Knocks are his running style, which doesn't win many Belmonts, coupled with fact only win this year was an off-the-turfer. May truly be at mercy of pace, but wet track is sure to help.

Every horses' lifetime record in turf races, a valuable tool in handicapping, is another highlight of the Past Performances in Daily Racing Form.

COLONIAL AFFAIR

Beyer number in Peter Pan was better than Sea Hero's Derby, making him automatic factor. Trainer said he moved too soon, otherwise result would've been different. Much improved with blinkers, and you could be looking at the best-bred 12-furlong horse in race. Don't mean to spoil the party, but remember, both wins this year were under 110 pounds, or 16 less than he'll carry today. If you like Virginia Rapids, you better like this one, too.

PRAIRIE BAYOU

Since 1955, only seven Preakness winners have won the Belmont, and three were Triple Crown winners. It's hard to find fault with a horse this consistent and who's done just about everything asked of him. Only faults are high dosage (it didn't stop Creme Fraiche or Conquistador Cielo) and uninspiring Beyers. Sire won 12-furlong Brooklyn in '86 in 2:26 2/5, so can't knock him on pedigree. He'll run out of gas someday, but there's no guarantee it'll be Saturday.

BULL INTHE HEATHER

His best races were in Florida with Lasix, now he's in N.Y. without the drug. Trainer has said he's gone a bit sour since leaving Florida, and turf debut last week was not awe-inspiring, even though he could have been ridden a lot better. But have hope Bull fans: Temperence Hill finished third on the grass in his Belmont prep, and new rider Chavez is really his old rider, having broken his maiden at Aqueduct in December.

RAGLAN ROAD

Last two in Crabcake Country weren't bad, but was well-beaten in all three starts at nine furlongs; stats are even worse against this kind of competition. Best Beyer number is a 91, which certainly won't cut it here.

EL BAKAN

Panamanian wonder horse improved in the Preakness on Lasix after bleeding in the Derby, but will be without the diuretic here. He held well for third three weeks ago, but would've been fourth had Personal Hope not bled profusely. While he won't face that kind of pace pressure here, only a handful of Belmont winners have gone wire-to-wire in recent times. He still hasn't run a Beyer higher than 90, and figures to call it an afternoon somewhere approaching the top of the stretch.

ARINTHOD

The key to the race. Mystery horse has won but once in his career, but narrowly missed in Group I company at 2 and ran into highly regarded Regency last month. He's been prepped overseas by the master trainer Francois Boutin and sparkling five-furlong work Wednesday gives every indication he's ready and will handle dirt. Got a feeling he's better than he looks on paper. Your move.

ONLY ALPHA

Hard to believe a horse who was beaten 10 lengths in a non-winners of one will do much damage here, especially considering he's one-for-eight and that one was in January. Bred to run all day and has all-important race and good works over track. Picks up weight; poor Beyer numbers; for longshot players only.

SEA HERO

It was Sea Hero in the Derby, Sea Goat in the Preakness. Which one will show up Saturday? We hated him in both races, but it's a different story this time around. He's the only two-time Grade I winner in the field and with rain in the forecast, a wet track makes him double tough. Also, 17 of the last 20 Derby winners have finished on the board in the Belmont, an 85 percent statistic. He's also bred as well as anyone to get the distance. What happened at Pimlico? Was it the dry, cuppy track? Did he bounce? Was it the loss of Lasix? If it was the latter, he may be in trouble. If it was something else, ignore him at your own risk.

SILVER OF SILVER

With a troubled winter behind him, it may be time to start realizing the potential he showed as a 2-year-old. He's been working like a champ here since the Derby, and reportedly looks much better than he did in Kentucky. He comes from out of it, but he showed a good move on the turn in the Remsen, something he'll have to reproduce to have any chance Saturday. Another coming off Lasix, but didn't need it last year. Would have preferred a prep; best races to come later on.

ANTRIM RD.

WILD GALE

Got a feeling he's just a Churchill Downs lover. Best races of his career came in Kentucky, other starts just don't cut the mustard. He doesn't have the profile of most Belmont winners, coming from double-digit lengths back. There are better closers with better acceleration. If he's close, we'll be the most surprised.
