<b>7 – REMINGTON PARK (8:54 ET)</b> <b>USEEIT 50K, 1M DIRT</b>  <b>8 EIREANN</b> 5-2 5 CALEB’S FINEST 12-1 1 FLORAS ORA 3-1 6 CHIT0Z’S BLUR 8-1  <b>PICK: 8 EIREANN</b> She is definitely the most accomplished in the field. She was flat in the comebacker going 7F three back but she improved in the last two when stretched out. The winner two back is 9 for 24 (17 in the top two) for 400k and won an open allowance next. She can get into the race early but has a good finishing kick. Clearly the one to beat here.  <b>VALUE: 5 CALEB’S FINEST</b> She was quite good in her first 6 starts. However, she was able to be just 3 runners when beaten 35 lengths last two times out. Despite those poor efforts, Bravo moves her up to stakes company. That could be a sign of confidence or it could be a place filler for the stablemate on the rail. Her best puts her in the mix. Rider 4 for 8 riding for Bravo. A) 8 B) 1,2,5,6 C) 4,7 D) 3	<b>81</b>	<b>8 – REMINGTON PARK (9:23 ET)</b> <b>JIM THORPE 50K, 1M DIRT</b>  <b>2 MISTER OMAHA</b> 1-2 5 CODE NATE 4-1 1 CLASSY EMPIRE 5-1 6 WORK ZONE 8-1  <b>PICK: 2 MISTER OMAHA</b> He sure looks like a standout in this race. He’s been with open class stakes company. He was third to the talented Bracket Buster in the G3 Ok Derby. He’s 6 for 6 when he’s in with Ok-breds (averaging winning distance is 8-lengths in those wins). Just looks way too good for this group but price will indicate that (likely 1/9). Will not lose this one.  <b>VALUE: 5 CODE NATE</b> This one appears to be the next best runner in here. But he’s stretching out for the first time. It’s possible the top choice allows this one to take control of the lead on this stretchout. Couldn’t get past the wire to wire winner last time out but stayed on well with a career top 88 Beyer fig earlier this month. Eligible to keep improving with racing. A) 2 B) 5 C) 1,6 D) 3,4	<b>98</b>	<b>9 – REMINGTON PARK (9:52 ET)</b> <b>TOBY KEITH 75K, 1M DIRT</b>  <b>4 NOT A LADY</b> 2-1 5 MISS CALL 8-5 6 MOJO PROMISE 9-2 1 ALISAL 5-1  <b>PICK: 4 NOT A LADY</b> Expensive Steve Asmussen filly. She went for 775k at the 2024 Keeneland September sale. The dam was a sprinter on turf for Asmussen who won 353k. The female line for this one leads back to Hot Novel. She is the dam of \$3.4M earner Behrens. Asmussen won this race last year by over 10 with Glee. Bred to go long. Should be right there today.  <b>VALUE: 6 MOJO PROMISE</b> This is the other Steve Asmussen filly. She also went for a hefty sum at the 2024 Keeneland September sale. She cost 500k. Eased in the debut at KEE but came back and crushed an overmatched field at Zia Park. She’s only had two races so it’s not known how good she is yet. When Asmussen won this race last year, Stewart Elliot was up. A) 4,5 B) 6 C) 1,2 D) 3	<b>65</b>
<b>10 – REMINGTON PARK (10:23 ET)</b> <b>SHE’S ALL IN 75K, 1M 70 DIRT</b>  <b>1 TAKE CHARGE MILADY</b> 2-1 2 PERFECT SHOT 4-1 6 THUNDERS ROCKNROLL 6-1 3 TAKE ME SERIOUS 5-1  <b>PICK: 1 TAKE CHARGE MILADY</b> She figures to get an absolutely dream trip in this spot as there are quite a few that will be sent early setting up fast fractions. While this one can press, her best running is from behind. Did little in the G1 last out when 4 <sup>th</sup> out of 4 beaten a long way. She was G1 placed four back in the Ashland. McPeck 19 for 44 (43%) in a stakes dirt route at 2-1 or less.  <b>VALUE: 6 THUNDERS ROCKNROLL</b> Mn-bred loves to win races. She is 10 for 29 in her career so far with 17 of 29 in the exacta. She comes into this in top form having won 4 of her last 5 starts. That includes an easy win here wire to wire last out. She typically goes to the front but has a few wins just tracking the pace in the early stages. That style will serve her well in this spot. A) 1 B) 2,3,6,7 C) D) 4,5	<b>74</b>	<b>11 – REMINGTON PARK (10:54 ET)</b> <b>JA HAWK MEMORIAL 75K, 1M 70 DIRT</b>  <b>1 HEROIC MOVE</b> 2-1 8 WILLY D’S 4-1 6 C W PRIZE 8-1 2 ZE’BUL 6-1  <b>PICK: 1 HEROIC MOVE</b> Robertino Diodoro charge has crushed in 2 of his last 3. He was beaten at 1-5 in between but still ran a credible second there. Last win in the Zia Championship put him over the \$1M earnings mark. He’s 2 for 3 here at RP and 4 for 13 (8 in the money) at the distance. He’ll be able to save ground from the rail. Looks like a deserving favorite.  <b>VALUE: 8 WILLY D’S</b> This is really the method of operation for trainer Michael Maker. He does exceptional work with high dollar claims (he took this one for 50k in the start 7 back). Since Maker has had this one, he’s run the top 3 Beyer Speed Figures of his career (in just 6 starts). Can excuse the fade in the last start setting the pace in the loaded G2 Lukas Classic. A) 1,8 B) 2,6,9 C) 3,5,7 D) 4	<b>70</b>	<b>12 – REMINGTON PARK (11:26 ET)</b> <b>SPRINGBOARD MILE 300K, 1M DIRT</b>  <b>1 ARCTIC BEAST</b> 4-1 7 SPICE RUNNER 3-1 9 WESTERN MAN 20-1 2 TIME FOR MUSIC 9-2  <b>PICK: 1 ARCTIC BEAST</b> Undefeated Ny-bred (3 for 3) ran roughshod over stakes at Finger Lakes in the last two starts at low odds. 4 <sup>th</sup> out of the debut win at Saratoga has since won the 500k New York Stallion at 12-1 at Aqueduct. Maker has had 5 starts at RP the last 5 years. He won 3 and was 2 <sup>nd</sup> in another. All 5 were in stakes. The dam won near 600k in her career.  <b>VALUE: 9 WESTERN MAN</b> There is no telling how good this one is. 7-2 in debut but ran like a 1-5 shot. Broke slow and was last first furlong. Moved up on the rail in tight for much of the run around the turn. Romped when clear. Quiet Dance in the female line. She is the dam of Saint Liam (\$4.4M won) and Quiet Giant (the dam of the champion Gun Runner, \$16M won). A) 1,7,9 B) 2,4,8,10 C) 3,6,12 D) 5,11	<b>66</b>
