GOODBYE HALO broke alertly and was allowed to settle off the early leaders while saving ground, worked her way forward along the inside on the second turn, angled three-wide entering the stretch, responded to right-handed pressure drawing to challenge a furlong out, then widened with her rider shifting to left-handed urging in the final sixteenth. JEANNE JONES sprinted to the fore at once, maintained the advantage under a nice hold, turned back the challenge of WILLA ON THE MOVE, but could not contain her stablemate. WILLA ON THE MOVE, well-placed from the outest, drew to challenge in midstretch, but was not good enough. COLONIAL WATERS, allowed to settle early, circled horses to gain a striking position on the second turn, then lacked a further response. LOST KITTY prompted the pace three-wide for six furlongs and gave way. LUCKY LYDIA passed tiring foes. MOST LIKELY, shuffled back a bit at the start, failed to menace. JOE'S TAMMIE raced within striking distance for six furlongs and retired. ON TO ROYALTY was not a factor. FULBRIGHT SCHOLAR gave way badly and was eased late. **Scratches** — Countess Midori. **Times** — :22½, :46½, 1:12, 1:37½, 1:50%.
