Real Quiet: Broke inside, improved between horses, led before mile lasted.

Victory Gallop: Outrun six furlongs, rallied 6 wide entering stretch, gaining.

Indian Charlie: Well placed backstretch, rallied between, weakened late.

Halory Hunter: Outrun early 6 wide stretch, mild late gain.

Cape Town: Improved position between horses, angled out stretch, mild gain.

Parade Ground: Outrun early, passed tiring rivals inside.

Hanuman Highway: Well placed inside, gave way.

Favorite Trick: Never far back, bid inside far turn, tired badly.

Nationalore: Came out start, failed to menace.

Old Trieste: Stumbled start, led entering backstretch, finished after mild.

Chilito: Factor while off rail, tired.

Robinwould: Wide, tired badly.

Artax: Off slowly, mild bid backstretch, tired badly.

Rock and Roll: Speed inside, for six furlongs, stopped badly.

Basic Trainee: Bumped start, checked sharply entering stretch, bore out eased.
