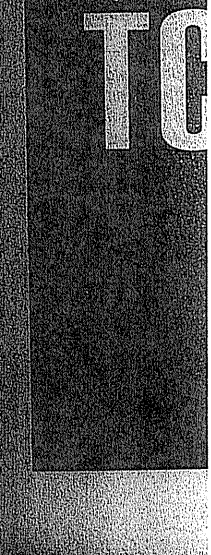

In the Gold

Drew away in the Gazelle in professional manner; likes the course and distance and is one of the more versatile runners in the field; outstanding workout on 10/16 over the deep Oklahoma training track in the mud; has finished out of the money only once and that race was around two turns.

Pleasant Home

Could not overcome the slow pace in the G1 Spinster and had to settle for secondary honors; she finished badly on a very wide path, rarely the place to be at Keeneland; consistent lass is several notches below on the Beyer scale, but remains an underrated runner; home is less.

Sweet Symphony

Was surprisingly only 2nd in against this same, capable crew in the Beldame and may have not fancied being sub down inside and then behind runners; draws an overcast post under Bailey today but will have to improve dramatically off last performance; identical breezes at five-eighths and a very encouraging sign.

Capeside Lady

Pressed the pace of Stella Jayne in the Ruffian only to run out of energy in the final furlong; that was a light effort though and she made a strong middle move (on a difficult path) in the Spinster race after, similar to Pleasant Home should be primed and ready and odds will be very appealing even with expert connections involved.
