1¼ MILES. (1.591) 145TH RUNNING OF THE TRAVERS. Grade I. Purse \$1,250,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$1,250 each which should accompany the nomination; \$9,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$9,750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$12,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse for the Travers shall be divided as follows: \$670,000 to the owner of the winner, \$230,000 to second, \$125,000 to third, \$85,000 to fourth, \$50,000 to fifth, \$35,000 to sixth, \$30,000 to seventh and \$25,000 to eighth. Weight 126 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 9, 2014 with 15 Nominations.

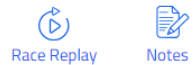

V. E. DAY dropped in on the initial straightaway, came a bit off the rail on the first turn, was ridden along passing the five-eighths pole, continued ridden along while still well off the pace, went around the far turn in the two path, turned into the stretch under the whip, rallied into the final furlong, shifted out while gaining approaching the sixteenth-pole and closed strongly to get up late in a long drive. WICKED STRONG moved up passing the wire the first time, went five wide early on the first turn then tucked into the two path, shifted four wide late on that bend, was forwardly placed on the outside while keeping a close eye on the two opponents in front of him, came under urging while three wide on the final turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch with a slim advantage, inched clear under a right-handed whip, shifted in when the rider took a peek back to his inside at the furlong marker, remained clear into the final sixteenth, was put to a strong hand ride late and was caught. TONALIST moved up passing the wire the first time, went four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, raced in the two path on the far turn, made a bid between horses at the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch side by side with the runner-up, dropped back under a drive and was outfinished but came home willingly to secure the show. KID CRUZ went three wide on the first turn, was urged along while well back in the field, raced three to four wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. MR SPEAKER settled off the pace while off the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths then shifted three wide, advanced into striking range, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. VIVA MAJORCA went two to three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, raced three then four wide on the far turn, advanced at the five-sixteenths, came six wide into the stretch and flattened out. CHARGE NOW saved ground on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, was hard ridden while inside on the far turn and failed to respond. ULANBATOR dropped in approaching the first turn, saved ground on that bend, settled well off the pace, was urged along while inside early on the far turn, came around a rival near the five-sixteenths and failed to threaten. COMMANDING CURVE dropped back after the start, raced a bit off the inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, shifted out under a left-handed whip at the top of the stretch and was no factor. BAYERN broke very fast, quickly took a clear advantage, was challenged before the first turn, saved ground on that bend, set the pace through solid fractions, vied inside while under pressure on the far turn, lost the lead approaching the quarter-pole, dropped out turning into the stretch and stopped.
