Secret Hello, in tight quarters between horses on the clubhouse turn, remained reserved while advancing after Sound Of Cannons on the far turn, then rallied in the drive to gain the lead outside that rival in deep stretch. Sound Of Cannons, rated on the early lead, opened up a sizeable advantage on the backstretch, then continued gamely in the drive although unable to last. Silver Ending, unhurried early, moved up between horses on the far turn, raced inside the winner in the upper stretch, then lacked the needed response in the final furlong. Appealing Breeze, a bit fractious in the gate, was unhurried while racing outside horses early, then finished willingly from well out in the track although lacking the needed closing rally. Buchman saved ground in contention for six furlongs, then gave way.
