**PICK: 4 EXODUS AND HOPE**

5 of the 6 runners in this race come out of the race won by wire to wire winner Hot Habanero. She was a Fonner shipper who quarterhosed out and went all the way. This one broke about 3 lengths slow in there. 5YO mare makes her 2<sup>nd</sup> start off the layoff.

**VALUE: 2 SURELY A LEGEND**

She did some heavy lifting in that common race on 5/21 won by Hot Habanero. She tried to run early with the winner and made a move into 2<sup>nd</sup> before tiring. Might have a touch more speed than many in here. Another making her 2<sup>nd</sup> start off the layoff.

**PICK: 3 MONGOL ALTAI**

Privately purchased after the last place finish two back at Santa Anita. Trainer Diodoro with owner C Garvey hits at 24% at CBY and has 4 wins and 7 in the exacta in his last 8 starts at CBY. Takes a class drop for this. Will get a good pace to run at in here.

**VALUE: 2 RISKY SITUATION**

Career maiden finally broke through for a win last out. That was his 23<sup>rd</sup> start in a maiden event. Has the best last out Beyer (68) so maybe he has finally turned the corner. Rider without a win so far but has 7 of 16 in money. Perfect pace situation for him.

**PICK: 4 PIPER ROSE**

The outside runner must break well and put some pressure on Tiz Wonderfully or that one could end up going wire to wire. This one is 5 for 8 in the top 3 at 1M on the dirt. She comes from off the pace so the early action will dictate if she can run into this.

**VALUE: 6 CRIMINAL RECORD**

This is a sprinter stretching out so she can be fast enough to outrun the favorite early if Lopez wants to send her. Major class drop after 3 wins in last 4 starts prior to that. Trainer hitting at 31% so far in 2022. This lightly raced 4 YO filly has some upside.

**PICK: 1 RICKEY B**

The 0 for 3 record with zero in the money on grass might deter some. But in two of those he was just two back at long odds sprints on turf vs better. He is back in the Miguel Hernandez barn and he got a 12-1 win with him at TUP four back. Stalks the pace.

**VALUE: 3 MIAMI CROCKETT**

Hard to overlook the 5 for 11 record going this 5F distance on the turf. He has switched barns a few times so don't know if this 5YO is the same runner that accomplished that record. Good second at TUP 3 back. Likes the turf. Will sit third early on in here.

**PICK: 2 LIBERTARIAN**

Fonner shipper was clearly best last out but had a miserable trip. He was steadied on the turn and in the early part of the stretch. He then was blocked for the last furlong. Faced some of the better foes at Fonner in opt clm out there. Will be moving late.

**VALUE: 3 HI HO CHEERIO**

Ships in from Will Rogers Downs where he was very close in two starts there. Had a good season here in 2021 with Valorie Lund. He won once and was in the exacta 3 times in 5 starts. Winner of the last 2 starts has won 3 straight in OK. Top rider Wade up.

**PICK: 1 NORTH ARM BABY**

In the money in 5 of 6 starts and the only time off the board was in a race where he had traffic. Good effort first off the layoff but likely moves up in 2<sup>nd</sup> off the break. Dam was a stakes winner on the turf and 2<sup>nd</sup> dam was also a stakes winner on the grass.

**VALUE: 2 THAT'S NOT FUNNY**

Very nice pedigree for the turf. Dam was all turf in her career and there are a couple of sibs who won on the grass. Faced the two best Mn-bred 3YO's in the two starts (Ben's Malice and Love the Nest). He is a first time gelding. Gets Lasix for the first time.

**PICK: 1 LAPIS LAZULI**

Ships in from Hawthorne and changes barns to a top trainer here, Joel Berndt. Had a miserable trip last out at Hawthorne. Won two back at KEE at 8-1 with a late surge. Trainer Berndt has had a strong start to the meet. Saves ground from the rail draw.

**VALUE: 7 PUBLIC SAFETY**

Mn-bred is approaching 100k in money won. Hasn't been out since the meet ended here in 2021 back in September. Trainer 0 for 3 off of layoffs this type at CBY but 3 of them hit the board. Late runner will get some pace in front of him to close into in here.

**PICK: 6 TAILORBESWIFT**

Sire was a graded stakes runner sprinting on grass for Larry Jones. There are some turf winners on the female side of the pedigree, as well. Won here first time out and that was sprinting at this 5F distance on the turf. Looked strong winning 10 days ago here.

**VALUE: 1 MISS GLORIOUS**

Tired chasing a fast pace here on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the meet. Goes to the turf for just the third time in her career. Was 3<sup>rd</sup> in MSW at Del Mar in first turf start (at 5F) and then 4<sup>th</sup> by 3 in a stakes at GG in the 2<sup>nd</sup> turf try (1M). Has class and appears to like the turf.

**PICK: 5 ZOE'S DELIGHT**

Mn-bred didn't fire first off the break last year (just as he didn't in the 10,000 Lakes this year) but won right back on the move to a route next when he won at 7-1 here. Winner of a 50k stakes last August has done better routing. Expecting much better in here.

**VALUE: 2 CENTRAL PARK**

6YO gelding likes to win races. Trained by David Van Winkle and owned by James Thares, he's won 9 of 20 career starts and is 4 for 12 at the distance. He won twice here last year vs. similar and started '22 with 19-1 upset at TUP. 2<sup>nd</sup> won an allw at CTM next.
