Cheapekate, in good position while reserved off the early pace, stayed four wide on the backstretch, gained the lead three wide on the stretch turn, came into the drive well out from the inner rail, gamely resisted when hooked by Broad Brush, then held the advantage while drifting out several times to brush lightly with that one under intermittent left-handed urging. Broad Brush mounted his rally four wide on the far turn, hooked the winner from the outside in the upper stretch and gamely battled for the lead through the drive. The inquiry sign was lit following the finish and after reviewing the stretch run the stewards ruled there was insignificant evidence for a disqualification. Peripat commenced his rally along the inside on the backstretch, angled outward to be three wide on the far turn, and finished with a good run. Blandford Park went far out in the track for the drive and continued with interest. Rampage made a nice move to contention four wide on the far turn, came into the stretch far out from the inner rail but could not sustain his momentum and flattened out. Smokey Orbit sat or forced the pace along the inside to the stretch turn and tired. Bachelor Beau, outside Smokey Orbit throughout, had little left for the drive. On Retainer, four wide into the clubhouse turn, raced forwardly for five furlongs and gave way. Clear Choice steadied when put in tight quarters between horses after the start, raced in midpack while outside horses for five furlongs and gave way badly.
