

**ON THIS DATE (2006) – CARELESS NAVIGATOR** won 9 of 17 starts all coming at Canterbury. He was a five-time stakes winner vs. Minnesota-bred company and earned over \$211K. On July 1, 2006, he beat a strong field of open class optional claiming runners at 6-1. He would end up winning 4 of 6 in 2006 to win the '06 Champion Older Horse and Champion Sprinter.
