## COMMENTS

- Real Quiet: Wide first turn, advanced five wide with 3½ furlongs left, came into the stretch six wide, won driving.
- Victory Gallop: Settled early, moved between horses with 4½ furlongs left, four wide move in second turn, made a bid with an eighth of a mile left, finished gamely.
- Classic Cat: Allowed to settle, had rail run in second turn, angled three wide, finished well.
- Hot Wells: Stumbled at the start, circled five wide into the stretch, flattened out.
- Black Cash: Prominent between horses at a half-mile, dropped back in second turn, tired.
- Spartan Cat: Saved ground, void early speed, failed to menace.
- **Baquero:** Sluggish start, rushed four wide to a clear lead, tired coming into stretch.
- Basic Trainee: Stalked pace three-wide, roused in second turn, tired in upper stretch.
- Cape Town: Well-placed, three-wide move in between horses with 3½ furlongs left, dropped buck suddenly.
- Silver's Prospect: Flipped in paddock, three-wide first turn, faltered.
