He beat 4 foes that day in a \$5,000 claiming event. By the end of the meet, he would beat stakes placed allowance foes for trainer Doug Huntington. He would not win another race.

PICK: 6 LATTE DOLCE
 Ships in from the Fair Grounds for a trainer who is 3 for 10 (30%) with 8 in the money (80%) at CBY in a MSW with a shipper from FG. Sib to Sheeza Milly Way who won 224k and was G3 placed on grass at Santa Anita. This filly cost 155k and ran 2nd in a MSW at KEE.

VALUE: 2 FLATTERINGAPPLAUSE
 Another runner for Eric Heitzmann (also has the top choice). This one was running on well to finish 4th in the common race won by Faded Memories. 2nd from that race (Church Service) set the pace in the Curtis Sampson Oaks and finished 6th beaten two at 30-1.

 Leading trainer Mac Robertson filly goes from turf to dirt and makes a pretty big drop in class. This is her first start for a tag. Robertson goes to his first call rider Canchari. She is 4 for 6 in the money on a fast dirt track. Drop makes sense given recent form.

VALUE: 7 SHES GOT IT
 Claimed three back and has run on a muddy track and the turf in 2 starts for these connections. She is 3 for 4 in the exacta on a fast dirt track. Riecken has been hot lately winning three times with deep closers at prices recent weeks. Minor award today.

 Really hasn't run a bad race since he came back off the year break (9 straight). While it looked like quick fractions in last, the turf that night was playing very fast. He was the only closer to make up ground late in there. Blocked for a run two back. Comes running.

VALUE: 5 BIG FALCON ROCKET
 Surprise package on the lead from the rail in most recent start at 11-1. Prior start on a firm turf was a runner-up finish here last September. He has early speed but can rate as he did a bit in last. Mn-bred is clearly a turf runner. Should get a good trip here.

PICK: 1 KISSALOT
 Field of 2YO's that have never run. This one draws a tough inside post and will need to have some early speed to hold the inside. Works are fast. Has a win early pedigree. Full sib (for same connections) won a MSW in debut sprinting on dirt. Top rider gets up.

VALUE: 5 BASALT STREET
 Trainer Gary Scherer is 9 for 22 (41%) with 15 in the money (68%) with a \$4.28 ROI with a debut 2YO. He had three such runners for this ownership and won two of them (13-1 and 10-1 odds). 2nd dam was a G3 placed runner and earner of 217k sprinting on dirt.

PICK: 4 JOHNNY UP
 Second time starter for top trainer Mac Robertson. Thought the race he exited (won by a debut runner with excellent breeding by 12 lengths) was a strong maiden. Two sibs (Wynn Time, Cinco Star) are stakes winners. Will need to get involved sooner in this one.

VALUE: 2 HOLDDENTIGHT
 Third time starter ran better in both starts than it may appear. Was chasing a fast pace in the debut at 48-1 and beat 8 foes home despite a tight start. Really tough task chasing the sensational winner early in last and was only beaten 4-lengths for 2nd.

 She's been in the money in 7 of 17 on the turf (all at Canterbury). Her last 3 turf starts produced 3 in the money and a win. Has a good late closing kick and will get a bit more distance to work with today. 3rd start off a layoff. He won 3rd off the break last year.

VALUE: 6 NORTH OF EDEN
 8YO mare comes in off a win. She's been claimed in two consecutive starts. Thought she was facing a bit better company at FG and in Texas prior to shipping to Canterbury. She has a good record on this turf (7 of 11 in money, 2 wins). Trainer having a strong meet.

Started to run when it was all over last time out in a strong opt clm race. The winner was a 14-1 Diodoro. Winner 3 back (Race Home) has won 4 straight in Az and all by open lengths (took a 20k stakes last time out). Top rider Quinonez up (is 2 for 4 up for Diodoro).

VALUE: 1 WARRIOR BOSS

Mn-bred has run two very good races in a row. The winner two back is a strong looking Mn-bred that is going to be a stakes winner soon. Beat a very good group in last at 5-1 with a big middle move. He has a couple of good works since last. Is a fit with these.

Fired in all 3 starts since moving to Rengstorf. He likely needed his last start. Not easy coming off a long break and running at 1M 1/16. The winner ran 5th beaten 4 in the Mystic Lake Mile at 26-1 in next start for Diodoro. He is 3 for 3 in money on the turf.

VALUE: 1 IM A COWBOY TOO

He ran in spots in the common race won by one of the foes in here, Shakes Creek. He ended up being beaten about 3 at 5-1. Moves to a new rider (Wade) in here and goes from the outside post to the rail. All 6 of his wins were at this distance. Saves ground.
