

ON THIS DATE – On this date in 1996, **CAMLAN** (an Ontario-bred) shipped in woodbine and won the \$150,000 Lady Canterbury Stakes at 4-1 odds by a head over favored Apolda. The win was even more significant as it brought back 47 year old Sandy Hawley to Canterbury for the first time since he was leading rider in 1986.

PICK: 4 IT'S BOBS BUSINESS

Sire Bolt d'Oro has stared 6 for 12 with debut runners. Female line includes the 2013 Grade 1 Carter (sprint) winner Swagger Jack. Deeper in the family is the '69 G1 Champagne winner Silent Screen. Last 6 times Berndt had a debut 2YO at 4.5F at CBY, he won 4, 2nd other two.

PICK: 2 SR. BOM BON

Smart placing here on the comeback. Gets in with two wins because he's a Mn-bred (race is restricted to non-winners of two lifetime unless a Mn-bred). Protected from the claim due to the layoff, comeback rules and placement. Just 3 races on a fast dirt track. Check tote.

PICK: 2 DOCTOR OSCAR

He's the only runner to have beaten Love the Nest (in that loaded debut that included stakes types Ben's Malice and Xavey Davey). Ran better than it looked in the two stakes races. Ducked out, wide in the No Lights two back. Was much the best in the comebacking win.

VALUE: 5 FISHERMAN OSCAR

Trainer David Van Winkle started three horses in their debut here in MSW at 4.5F as a two-year old when they were ridden by Lindsay. He won twice at odds of 15-1 and 6-1 and was second in the other at 18-1. Sire won the BC Dirt Mile and his offspring include Monomoy Girl.

VALUE: 6 ELUSIVE FREUD

Two of the last three starts came on turf and he didn't appear to want that surface. Faced much better in the start two back. Ran pretty well vs. mdn clm company at OP prior to arriving at CBY. Good to see the 2021 top rider Wade back up. Don't think we've seen his best yet.

VALUE: 4 GIVE EM HECK BECK

Good runner-up effort in an open allw last start. That winner, Exxel, crushed overmatched foes in his next start on June 22. Just a single win in 24 starts for this 4YO gelding but has been runner-up 10 times. Been in the money in 7 of 8 at the distance. Must use in exotics.

PICK: 4 CHOCOLATEICCECREAM

Interesting claim by high percentage outfit Broberg in the last start. This closer hadn't shown much. Broberg is 4 for 11 with 10 in the money in the starts where he had this one in his care (but it's been a while). 4 for 9 at the distance. Will improve under new management.

PICK: 3 MRS. BEANS

Thought he was game in defeat last out. The fractions were fast and contested (:23 move from 1st quarter to 2nd quarter). This one drifted out pretty badly in upper stretch. Cutback to 6.5F seems a perfect spot. Stakes placed Ark-bred gets the 2021 leading rider Wade today.

PICK: 2 ROZEY CHEEKS

One of three Mn-breds in the race. She exits common race on 6/9 that four runners in here ran in. The speed was too fast (runners traveling 1st, 2nd, 3rd in the early stages finished 7th, 10th and 11th). Goes back to Fuentes who was up for a third two back. Will save ground here.

VALUE: 6 I WILL YEAH

This one normally runs his race. Last time with a poor finish was 8 starts ago at GG when 10th but was taken up badly in that race. Been in the exacta in 3 of 5 at the distance. New rider Bridgmohan gets aboard. Is able to press or rate. Gives the rider some options in here.

VALUE: 6 PRINCE RAMA

Mn-bred was a surprising third in the 10000 Lakes on opening night. He was off at nearly 40-1 but ran third behind two very good runners that dead-heated. That race included comeback winner Astronaut Oscar (was 5th beaten 9). Might take back a bit more in this event.

VALUE: 10 FOXGLOVE

Gets credit for running into that fast pace from a rail draw last out and hanging in there for third. She likes to come from off the pace and will do that today with the move outside and addition of Quinonez who rode her many times. She faced better at Tampa previously.

PICK: 8 CASEY'S LAW

Outfinished in the debut by another Mac Robertson 1st timer who was second favorite at 9-5. Those two were over 5 clear of the rest of the field. Might have gone too fast early as he opened up on the turn. Has a bullet drill since. Female line includes 300k turf earner, Pink Poppy.

VALUE: 6 PRINCE OF EARL

This is the 1st starter here at CBY for quality Midwestern trainer Lynn Chleborad. She obviously sends this one North for the turf. This 4YO gelding ran well on the turf at RP last fall (twice in the money in three starts, all at this distance). 4 next out winners from the race 2 back.

PICK: 6 JESS DASH SUSIE

Good start to this meet for trainer Mallory Norton (has 5 in the money from 11 starts). This one was just 2nd in a similar spot at nearly 5-1 shipping in from RP. Looks like the 250 yards was a tad sharp for her and now she gets extra 80 yards to work with. Perfectly drawn post.

VALUE: 3 APOCALLTICAL JAMES

Comes in with 3 solid efforts in a row. Key race 2 back at RP. The winner was beaten a head in a RP allw next out. 2nd, 3rd, 4th all won next in mdn races at RUI, RP, RP in good times). Sib to two graded stakes placed horses and one of them was trained by this trainer Vic Hanson.
