**Belmont Park 1 1/2 Miles (2:24) Belmont-G1 149th Running of THE BELMONT.** presented by NYRABets. Grade I. Purse \$1,500,000 For Three Year Olds. By subscription of \$600 each, to accompany the nomination, if made on or before January 14, 2017, or \$6,000, if made on or before March 20, 2017. At any time prior to the closing time of entries, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$75,000 to the New York Racing Association, Inc. \$15,000 to pass the entry box and \$15,000 additional to start. All entrants will be required to pay entry and starting fees; but no fees, supplemental or otherwise shall be added to the purse. The purse to be divided \$800,000 to the winner, \$280,000 to second, \$150,000 to third, \$100,000 to fourth, \$60,000 to fifth, \$45,000 to sixth, \$35,000 to seventh and \$30,000 to eighth. 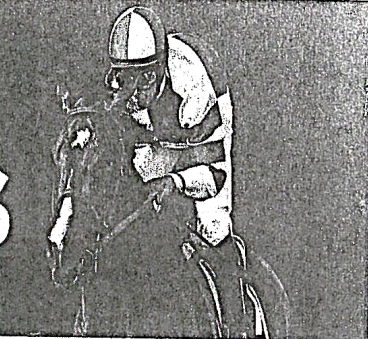

CLOSER LOOK 4 of the last 8 Belmont Stakes winners raced in the Kentucky Derby then skipped the Preakness; raced wide every step of the way from post 18 in the Derby; seemed to be in good position but did not fire; it was a disappointment because he produced his Beyer-career Top on a wet track in the Sham but produced his lowest-2017 speed figure on the wet-CD oval; his grandsire won the Belmont Stakes; jockey Espinoza was aboard American Pharoah's Belmont Stakes triumph; trainer rarely wins with similar absentees.

CLOSER LOOK Maybe returning to New York and a fast track will help his form as he looked like a good thing in his last-NY start in the G3-Gotham when producing a field-best Beyer speed figure; was troubled in the Kentucky Derby from the gate break noting both wins occurred when racing 3rd and 4th at the 1st call; needs to break sharper for any hope of turning the tables; 4 of the last 8 Belmont Stakes winners raced in the Kentucky Derby then skipped the Preakness; his grandsire won the Belmont Stakes; dam's sire finished 8th in the Belmont.

CLOSER LOOK Considering the Kentucky Derby and Preakness winners raced close to the pace (2nd and 3rd at the 1st call) he gets credit as one of a few running late in those events which could set him up nicely for this; nearly overcame the rail draw in the Derby being the 1st horse since 1988 to finish in the money from the 1-post position; the knocks against are he hasn't won since last summer and not past 7f; doing a rain dance earning his best Beyer on a wet track; trainer Asmussen goes for his 2nd straight victory in the Belmont Stakes (Creator 2016); in the last 10 Belmont Stakes the only runner to have competed in both Triple Crown events then captured the Belmont was American Pharoah.
