TEN MOST WANTED broke inward brushing with PEACE RULES at the start, bumped with CONGRATS going into the first turn, settled in good position entering the backstretch, raced in hand while tucked in behind the leaders for six furlongs, angled out leaving the three-eighths pole, closed the gap to challenge on the turn, drew on even terms with PEACE RULES in upper stretch, surged to the front approaching the furlong marker then drew off under a vigorous hand ride. PEACE RULES rushed up from outside to contest the early, dueled through brisk fractions along the backstretch, fought heads apart along the rail to the top of the stretch, hung in gamely into midstretch, but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth. STRONG HOPE moved up along the rail to gain a slim early advantage, set the pace under pressure along the inside to the turn, dropped back leaving the quarter pole and gradually tired thereafter. WILD AND WICKED trailed to the top of the stretch and failed to threaten while improving his position. CONGRATS steadied after bumping with the winner and hitting the rail on the first turn and failed to seriously threaten thereafter. SKY MESA broke awkwardly, moved quickly into contention while three wide on the first turn, raced just outside the leaders along the backstretch, was put to the whip nearing the far turn, then gave way after going seven furlongs.
