

ON THIS DATE – On this date in 1988, **DON'S IRISH MELODY** beat **WHO DOCTOR WHO** with a nose in the third **Chaucer Cup**. Many consider it to be the greatest race ever run at CBY. They were nose to nose through the entire stretch and clear of third. The final time of 1:14 flat for 6 1/2 furlongs was just 1/5 off the then world record.

PICK: 3 IT'S HER TIME

Ran off and hid for top trainer Mac Robertson in a stellar debut. Robertson is 7 for 18 (39%) with 13 in the money (72%) with a second timer here at CBY who won their first start. Beyer of 68 is top in this field. Fast 5F workout since the debut win.

VALUE: 2 GYPSY REWARD

Other runner for Mac Robertson. She comes into this off a solid runner-up on the turf routing as a 7-2 chance. She was 6-wide in that race and lost a lot of ground. Top rider Wade gets up (he's won at 34% for Robertson). Possible to upset top pick.

7YO Mn-bred mare has been in the money 11 turf races out of 18 starts. All 4 of her turf wins came at this track. Was unprepared at the start in last race at FG. Draw a line through that one. Won off the bench in 2020 here. She's another late runner.

VALUE: 1 LEATHER AND LACE

Toss the last start which was moved from the turf to dirt. She is very much a turf runner. Prior two on turf, at Sam Houston, produced a win and 2nd place finish. She's 8 of 19 at the distance on turf. Top rider Wade is up. Will be scrapping the paint.

VALUE: 6 FINAL TABLE

Willing to excuse her first four starts. Those were at much tougher Oaklawn Park and without Lasix (which she got for the first time in her last start). Off slow and ran evenly at 1M in last. Might have more kick on the cutback in distance in this race.

VALUE: 4 ROCKYMOUNTAINTWIST

Faced decent company at TUP and at ARP before that. Lone turf start was three back at TUP in opt clm 25k company. He was 52-1 and finished last. He might not want turf or maybe that was just a tougher spot. Class drop should help in this one.

3rd gen of the female family includes the 3-time G1 winner (\$1.5M earner) Raging Fever. Deeper in the tree is the 1987 BC Distaff winner Sacahuista. Trainer Rengstorf has 3 wins and 5 in exacta with debut MSW dirt sprints at CBY (won with last two).

VALUE: 7 BAILOUT KELA

4 races for this filly and she finished second all 4 times. Was well-beaten for the win in the last two starts. Winner in last, 3-5 favored Mac Robertson filly, came back to run 2nd in allw. Show finisher ran 2nd in MSW last Sunday. Quinonez stays here.

Beat the top choice to the wire in last but did so by way of hindering that one for most of the way. Has speed but will likely have to deal with others in the early stages. Trainer Tony Rengstorf wins a lot of races here. He claimed him out of last start.

VALUE: 5 BEHAVIN MYSELF

Trainer Tony Rengstorf and owner Daniel Mlcovic claimed this one for 10k from Oaklawn Park last out. Winner won twice since (last time in str allw) at OP. Runner-up won for 16k. Lone start for this owner was 4th beaten a half 1st off the claim at OP.
