Brown 6 for 9 (67%) with 8 in the exacta 2nd off a year plus layoff on dirt in allw in NY at 4-1 or less.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 SANSONE Sold for 1.3M in 2023 as the sibling to the \$14M earner Midnight Bisou. That one was a 13-time graded stakes winner for Steve Asmussen. Seemingly put it together in the last start when he crushed a MSW group at GP by over 6 lengths. The runner-up was well clear of third in there. She had back to back wins, including one on this track over With the Angels two back, before a flop at 3-5 odds at LRL last out. She went to the bench after that poor start and has come back with some very sharp works.
