<p>1 - MOUNTAINEER PARK (7:00 PM) 62 CLAIMING 12K, 5F TURF</p> <p>1 TIMELY SECRET 4-1 4 DADDY CLASSY DILL 6-5 6 MORNIN' BOSS 7-2 8 OUT ONA LIMB 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 1 TIMELY SECRET Went right to the front in the last start as the even money favorite but stopped. Something went off there as the other two turf starts here were strong. Figures to get out quickly again from the rail. The trainer hitting at 30% here. Tossing the last start.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 OUT ONA LIMB Almost pulled off a 44-1 upset at this distance 2 back. She broke from the rail and pressed early in there before tiring late. She beat WV-breds on this turf last year. Can discount the last start. She was over her head in there. New sire has a 25% win rate with turf sprinters so far (4 for 16). Tried tougher Ind-bred MSW company first two times out. Good effort in last when 2nd to a big favorite.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 BALLOT BOX Typically, this turf favors those who have shown an affinity for it. This one was a 13-1 runner-up in the last start vs. similar when setting a fast pace. The winner has since won an allowance on turf at 14-1 here (68 Beyer). That was at a mile and he was used early in a fast time and had little left late. The 5F sprint on turf two back was good enough to compete here. The runner-up goes in the prior race. See how he does.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 TAJI MIKE This trainer has privately purchased quite a few of the Capuano horses and started them at MNR in the recent past. She does have a couple of wins on that move. This one was facing a lot better in Maryland. Has turf in the pedigree. This one ran well in 2 starts at MNR last fall and has faced much better since leaving. 3rd from last start went to AQU and ran 2nd in 100k allow. Rider 29% for Reed at MNR.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 ISLANDINTHSTREAM Was 7-2 odds in the first local start last time out but missed the break and couldn't get back into it. She was hung out wide in the 9 post and now gets the inside. Ran pretty well in the other grass race (4th in MSW at FG in debut). Will show speed.</p> <p>A) 6 B) 1,2,3,4 C) 5 D) 7</p>
<p>5 - MOUNTAINEER PARK (8:40 PM) 75 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 16K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>3 FRACING WILDCAT 1-2 6 ZIPSY ROSE LEE 9-2 7 TEAM MOM NOT BRUH 8-1 5 WAY OF APPEAL 10-1</p> <p>PICK: 3 FRACING WILDCAT She beat a few of these in the last start as the 2-5 favorite but not be a whole lot. She's been second in all 3 starts and runs for very high percentage connections. She will be favored again and is the deserving favorite but would consider others too.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 ZIPSY ROSE LEE Always have to pay attention to those shipping in here from MVR. She's been facing maiden claim company but that is parallel to the MSW here at MNR. Indiana-bred has faced better most races and ran well twice here at MNR. This one was able to win at TP at nearly 60-1 in the 7 back start. Last two were poor but was vs. a bit tougher. Trainer 30% shipping to MNR and under 3-1 odds. Will improve.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 UNCAPTURED FAITH Could be dangerous on the stretchout in this one. She sprinted in the last two and showed a bit of early speed in both. She might be clear up front today. All 3 of her wins came at the distance. She faces some very suspect foes. Her last 4 figs are higher than virtually everything else in the race. She's picked up checks in stakes and beat open class MSW at PIM. Trainer wins a lot of races (112 so far in '24).</p> <p>VALUE: 5 YES TO LOVE She was in the same key race the top choice exits last time out. The top two finishers won an op clm at CT and allowance at CT in their next starts. Did outrun her odds two back when she ran 3rd at CT at 14-1. In the exacta in 4 of 8 on a fast dirt track.</p> <p>A) 6,7 B) 1,4,5 C) 2,3 D)</p>	<p>8 - MOUNTAINEER PARK (9:55 PM) 57 CLAIMING 4K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>6 SIR AGGRAVATOR 3-1 5 CHACO SPIRIT 7-2 9 CATES SWOOSH 5-2 4 PROFESSIONAL 6-1</p> <p>PICK: 6 SIR AGGRAVATOR Doesn't win often (just 5 for 35) and comes into this on a 14-race losing streak. But he's beaten a few of these lately and is one who should be on the early pace. Was reclaimed by these connections 3 back. He doesn't face all that tough in this one.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 CHACO SPIRIT Unlike many in the race, he doesn't mind getting his picture taken. He's won 3 of his past 13 and is shipping in from tougher tracks (TDN and MVR) for this. Trainer just an 8% type but has 2 wins at the meet (same horse).
