He has a positive ROI on that move (\$2.34). Favored in the last start but lost momentum when he got shuffled at a key moment. Prior starts are good enough to win this.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 RUNNING SPARTAN</b>                  Favored on the class drop in last but had traffic trouble in the race and lost his best chance. He might be just in behind, or in front, of the rail runner who will be long odds. Blinkers come off for the first time. Worth noting Rispoli is off and joins the top choice. Likely sits far back early and run on late. He'll be forgotten at the window.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 2 COOPERKLIMT</b>                  Was nearly 40-1 two back and hung in gamely for a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish behind Warrens World. Thought he outran his odds when 4<sup>th</sup> last out despite a slow start. That was in a bit better company than he faces here. Beyer of 58 or better in 11 of the last 16. Quarterhorse rider allowed her to go to the front to hold the rail. Glatt won 5 of last 8 second start off the claim (7 of 8 in the money). She will be allowed to fall off the pace more here. 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<p>4 – SANTA ANITA (5:07 ET) 76 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 50K, 1M TURF</p> <p>2 EARNED NOT GIVEN 4-5 5 DYNODAVE 3-1 6 CHECK'S ON THE WAY 5-2 3 IT'S A FACTOR 12-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 2 EARNED NOT GIVEN</b> Impressive win off a long layoff two back. He was off a bit slow but came rolling home as the near 3-1 favorite in there. Winner of the last start was the 4-5 favorite in that small field. He was dropping out of a Grade 3 here on turf. Will be overbet for high percentage connections.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 5 DYNODAVE</b> Both starts routing on the turf were good. Those last 2 starts indicate he wants the distance. He closed into a slow pace in both but was strong in the lane. Second in the start two back won a MSW on turf with a 71 Beyer fig. He was under 6-1 in the second start but stopped yet again. He has been gelded since that race, gets first time Lasix and drops in class. Clockers indicate the workouts are very good for this. It's now or never time for this gelding.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 8 GREY AREA</b> He beat 7 foes at 27-1 when second in the first start at LRC. Chased 3 wide from the wide post two back in a decent effort. Did little after breaking on top last start. Blinkers come on, adds an exceptional gate rider and takes the needed class drop. He is 6 for 13 (46%) allowance to claiming in turf races in last year. 3 of the 7 losses were runner-up finishes. Winner of the start two back ran 4<sup>th</sup> in the G1 American Oaks and then won the G3 Megahertz. Tracks the pace.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 DENDERA</b> Blinkers get removed today (they were only on in last 3 starts). She stretches out to a mile from a sprint and that will have her right up on the pace today. She has handled routing in the past (9 for 15 in the money at 1M on the turf). He comes in with two straight wins vs. overmatched Cal-bred stakes company and career top 103 Beyer last out. Only two times out of the top 2 came in G2's when he was third in each. He can press the pace or close in. Hernandez was up in first 7 starts.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 2 ANARCHIST</b> Connections thought enough of him to try the \$1M G3 Korea Sprint last out. He beat 12 foes when 3<sup>rd</sup> in that very tough race. Won the G3 Pat O'Brien. That was after he was beaten a head in the G1 Bing Crosby to talented The Chosen Vron. Expecting him to make a late move.</p> <p>A) 1 B) 2,3,4 C) 6 D) 5</p>	<p>8 – SANTA ANITA (1:00 ET) 60 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 60K, 6.5F TURF</p> <p>8 JUNGLE PEACE 9-2 1 ENTRESSA 2-1 4 PAARL 15-1 9 FAVOR TO YOU 15-1</p> <p><b>PICK: 3 GRAND ASPEN</b> Trainer Phil D'Amato is 31% (5 for 13) when he has one in a MSW shipping in from overseas and Rispoli aboard. This filly was 100-1 in the debut. She got away poorly but was able to stay within 3-lengths. She beat 21 foes in the 2 starts. The clockers have liked her AM activity.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 PAARL</b> Can excuse both starts. Had a tough rail draw first out at Del Mar and was blocked for run down on the inside there. Went long vs. males last out and faded. Comes back with Lasix and cuts back. It's turned out to be a great claim. He's won 3 of 7 starts for these connections. He earned 85+ Beyers in 5 of 7. Only one to run back from the last start was the 4<sup>th</sup> place finisher who won here vs. open class opt clm. Beat him to win.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 3 MIO BAMBINO</b> The last start routing was almost too awful to be taken seriously. Prior starts sprinting were decent. Drew the 11 post two back at LRC and traveled 6-wide. That isn't the place to be at that track. Off slow and wide in three back start. Trainer Ryan Hanson has had 4 debut starters in MSW company with this quarterhorse rider up. He won all 4 of those including one on the turf sprinting. Sire fee for this one is just 4k but he sold for 50k. Can’t draw a lot from the slow works. Check betting for any tote action.	One of the ways to tell how good a performance is by a winner is to check the way they are spread out behind that one. This one left a lot of wobbly foes in her wake in the 150k stakes win last out. Faced males at KEE in the start two back. Trainer sneaky-good in 2024 (20%).	Leading trainer took this one a year ago for 50k. He was able to turn him into a stakes winner 5 starts later in a 100k at 1M 1/2 at LRL. He’s 5 for 12 (with 9 in the top 3) on a synthetic course. Winner two back returned to run 2 <sup>nd</sup> in similar and has won nearly 700k. Will be closing.

This trainer rarely has them cranked up early. He is 20 for 322 (6%) with a horse who is making either their 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> or 3 <sup>rd</sup> start. He improves dramatically after. Had a tough trip in the debut and then broke in the parking lot in the next two starts routing. Good gate rider is up.	First two starts were very good. Apprentice aboard in that debut at Delta and she romped by over 9 earning a 74 Beyer. Just missed in the 100k stakes at FG in the next start. The winner returned to win a 150k FG stakes (87 Beyer). Toss last as something went amiss routing.	Hasn’t run since 9/20/23. That is nearly 17 months off. Connections must feel there is still something here as they have him right in a good stakes without a prep. Won twice and beaten a neck in the 250k Rushaway on this track in 2023. Does have a couple of bullet works.
