


ON THIS DATE (1989) – PRESENT VALUE came to Minnesota for the \$150,000 G3 Canterbury Cup as a three-time graded stakes winner. On August 13, 1989, Present Value, ridden by Frank Oliveras (father of TVG's Christina Blacker) romped in the Cup by 4. Later in that season, he finished 4th in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic behind Sunday Silence and Easy Goer.

Has outrun his odds in both starts on grass.
