If rules described in this paragragh result in the exclusion of any horse, the \$5,000 entry fee previously paid will be refunded to the owner of the said horse. The above conditions not withstanding, no horse which earns purse money in the Kentucky Derby shall be denied the opportunity to enter and start in the Preakness. A replica of the Woodlawn Vase will be presented to the winning owner to remain his or her personal property. Second closing at a fee of \$6,000 each Saturday, March 30. Closed

Timeform chaps gave him a heady 108 rating for last year; mom is an unraced half-sister to near Triple Crown winner Majestic Prince; McLaughlin got Key of Luck to run well first time in the U.S., but he had Dubai dirt experience...this one does not; most of his foes have at least a 10f and 9f race in them, so he may be giving some foundation away; still not willing to draw a line through him off a strong U.S. debut.

Cavonnier

It took one of the great rides of all time by Bailey and a lot of luck to keep this guy from wearing roses...and even at the wire many thought the Cal-bred still got the win; if the Derby had been at this distance (1 3/16 miles) this guy would have won clear; very tractable, and style suits the prevailing stalker/closer bias that has won the Preakness far more often than not - in fact, not since Aloma's Ruler won wire to wire in '82 has the winner had the lead before the stretch call; and of those 13 winners, 5 didn't even have the lead till wire; the McCarron has Preakness win Alysheba; another Calbred gelding named Snow Chief lost the Derby but rebounded to win the Preakness; no Grindstone to worry about, and he beat Prince of Thieves by almost 4 in Kentucky...and of the horses who finished 4th through 9th, only Editor's Note comes back to challenge him; looks good, and one ex-QH trainer seems the biggest threat to another ex-QH trainer's Triple Crown win streak.

Victory Speech

Take the Lukas factor away from this horse and he'd probably be judged even more harshly - after all, except for the Fountain of Youth his other graded stakes efforts weren't much; got drilled by Roar who subsequently lost Lexington and last weekend's Withers (never really a threat); Santos said he had a bunch of horse in the Derby till they straightened away, and that maybe "...the distance was too much...": well, he only gets a 16th of a mile less today; a big price for Lukas fans.

In Contention

Poorly named for the Derby effort, but his lack of tactical speed and the big Derby field made his task mighty tough; it's a smaller field, and lack of speed hasn't been as big a drawback in the Preakness; speed handicappers won't be too thrilled with him, however, with just one fig over the century mark and other closers appear more eligible to improve or run big; outsider.

Secreto de Estado

Callejas/Perez finished 3rd in '93 with El Bakan at big odds, but for the most part their entrants in G1 races have been found wanting; his U.S. style has worked well in this race, but he does have some speed (went wire to wire in his debut win in Panama); daddy won the Travers, chased Spectacular Bid through the Triple Crown races without being embarrassed; still must view with a healthy amount of skepticism.

Louis Quatorze

Nick was at a loss to explain the dull Derby effort, but Nick is singing the horse's praises this week: "This horse has so much ability – he's got to run good. If he doesn't, I'll be extremely disappointed.."; after his strong:59 4/5 5f move at Pimlico Tuesday Zito exclaimed "That's the best I've ever seen him work..."; Zito's Go for Gin was favored in '94 off the Derby win and was a good 2nd, his Strike the Gold, favored in '91 off the Derby win, finished 6th; main dilemma with the Florida Derby and Blue Grass runners is how you rate them – after all, the Derby winner, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 7th and 8th finishers came from elsewhere, only Unbridled's Song (5th) and Editor's Note (6th) came from the 2 aforementioned heats; Pat Day up after getting bounced from Prince of Thieves, and he's been aboard the last 2 Preakness winners (also won on Tank's Prospect in '85); eligible to bounce back, but still pretty iffy.

Feather Box

If Angel could win this with this guy it would cause nearly as much a stir as his controversial winning ride on Codex; Beyer boys will not be impressed; Wood effort was okay, no great shakes, but he's had ample time off since; speed to be up near the pace; sire's sire won this race in '81; outsider.

Mixed Count

Race over the track sure won't hurt, but from a speed figure standpoint he's taking a knife to a gunfight...and even his race over the track wasn't much and the horse who whipped him on the square is also in here; in the last 25 Preakness runnings, 21 of the winners had run in the Derby; outsider.

Look familiar? he's following nearly the identical path as his 3/4 brother Timber Country who won this race last year - both were dull in the SA Derby, both ran on decently to be 3rd in the Ky. Derby; the Lukas streak is hard to believe, and he gets Bailey to ride - it's possible no jock in history has maintained such a high level of performance in big races as Jerry the past few years; horse still has plenty of room to develop; one of the 2 horses who beat him in Ky. is retired, and the 2 who finished 4th and 5th right behind him are not here, either; Lukas for 7? quite possibly.

Editor's Note

Plodding plodder gets his kind of race – the Preakness has been dominated by stalker/closers in recent years with only 2 wire-to-wire winners in the past 25 runnings; main problem is that it's been nearly 9 months since that last win; for all those in-themoney finishes he really has never threatened as a 3yo; the Lukas factor won't hurt, and it's interesting that in the last 25 years, only Lukas (Codex, Tank's Prospect, Tabasco Cat and Timber Country), Van Berg (Gate Dancer, Alysheba) and Bohannan (Pine Bluff, Prairie Bayou) have more than one Preakness win; shaky, and count your lucky stars if you loved him in the Derby, bet him and cashed when Grindstone got there.

Skip Away

Did he bounce like a rubber ball, or, as trainer Hine insists, not handle the CD strip? could have been a little of both after a careertopping effort in the Blue Grass when he Beyered through the roof on the muddy, floated track; Hine reports runner's looking like his old self since the Derby; many a horse who ran poorly while well fancied in the Derby came back to run big in the Preakness; without Honour and Glory and Unbridled's Song, however, there's not much speed in here, and despite the reputation for speed doing well in the Preakness,...well, it's an old wives' tale - in the past 25 runnings, only 2 horses have gone wire to wire; respect.

Tesio winner sure looked good, but his other foray into the big time (Florida Derby) found him wanting considerably; hardly flattered by subsequent form of Flamingo winner El Amante who got beat in the Illinois Derby; others who missed the Derby but still ran well here include Oliver's Twist, El Bakan, Alydeed and Cherokee Run; unlike any of these Cherokee however, he's the one with a win over the track, and that 97 Beyer, while still inferior to the big boys, isn't all that bad; local hope Oliver's Twist ran huge here last year, so track affinity and missing a tough race like the Ky. Derby certainly gives him an exotics shot.
