**PICK: 1 SHE'S A TEMPEST**  
 First timer has some very nice works leading into this. 2<sup>nd</sup> dam won 5 of 7 career starts, all sprints, 3 of which were 2YO stakes races about 20 years ago. Sire was a G1 winner who gets 12% with debut 2YO's. Trainer Knapp has 2 wins and 10 in the money from his last 12 first time 2YO starters on dirt a MSW. He has a win and all 6 in the money with such when Pereira up.

**VALUE: 2 AFFAIR**  
 The last 8 times Richard Mandella had a first timer sprinting on the dirt in a MSW with Prat up, he won 4 of them (50%) and was in the money in 7 of those 8. Has a perfectly spaced work pattern for this highlighted by a strong 6F effort at SA. Sire won a BC Sprint and is 16% with dirt sprinters.

**PICK: 5 TABLE FOR TEN**  
 The race two back at GG was a key race. Of the 9 horses to have run back, 2 won, 4 more ran second and another ran 3<sup>rd</sup>. In other words 7 of the 9 to have run back hit the board. That includes the 5<sup>th</sup> place finisher, Caisson, who beat #2 Mo Rewards at SA. Was beaten a length in the same condition and distance here in early Aug with Fresu up. Will be finishing best of all.

**VALUE: 2 MO REWARDS**  
 It's almost as if the race was written for him. It calls for those who started for 16k claiming in the last two years. This one did that once (4 back) and won. Nice 3<sup>rd</sup> in the first start with Mullins. Last place finisher won on Sat at 11-1 in 20k clm. 4<sup>th</sup> ran 2<sup>nd</sup> at 3-1 in 35k clm at SA next. Rispoli is back up.

**PICK: 3 FLYNN'S CHANCE**  
 Richard Mandella has 3 wins and 6 in the top two from the last 10 starts going sprint to route on the dirt in a second career start. It's worth noting that Mandella and Spendthrift have the full sibling who won her first time routing (3<sup>rd</sup> career start) and then took a G3 routing on the dirt in the start afterwards. 5<sup>th</sup> from debut won a MSW by 11 next. Looks more serious here.

**VALUE: 1 PACIFIC ROSE**  
 Nothing wrong with the first start routing. That came in a Grade 2 at 54-1 last time out. She was 4<sup>th</sup> beaten just over two. Winner two back is now 2 for 2 after taking an 85k stakes at SA next. 5<sup>th</sup> won a MSW next. Has a long distance pedigree. Sire had Epicenter and the top marathon runner Next.

**PICK: 2 BAG'S GOLD**

Huge win two back on the class drop. The word must have been out as he was claimed. Favored on the bump up in class but he drew the widest 12 post and found a strong field. There were 4 next out winners from there and 8 of 9 who ran back hit the board in the next start. Clockers say he's looked good prepping for this. Hess has 3 wins from last 7 starts in So Cal.

**VALUE: 5 COLT FICTION**

7-time winner in just 22 career starts. Claimed two back by Peter Miller for this 20k price. Drew the rail and stalked the pace at Santa Anita last time out and finished decently. Now back on the dirt he likes. He's 5 for 10 at Del Mar for nearly 200k. Should see some tiring speedballs up front.

**PICK: 5 AMERICAN HOPE**

He got quite the education in the first start. Shuffled badly in the first half of furlong going from 5<sup>th</sup> to 2nd to last in two jumps. Then was steadied a bit in midstretch before finishing well. D'Amato goes from 8% in debut on turf to 28% (12 for 43) second out on turf going sprint to route (3 for 4 with such in a MSW with Prat). The dam was a multiple G1 winner on turf/synth.

**VALUE: 2 EL REY REY**

Comes out of the same race as the top choice. He had a lot of trouble in the race while finishing full of run. He was coming up the rail off the turn but was stopped and had to swing out wide. He was finishing fastest late in the race. Sire won the G1 BC Mile on grass at Santa Anita at 30-1 in 2014.

**PICK: 6 CHIMOSA**

Star of the stable. She rattled off back to back stakes wins here as a 2YO and both were perfectly ridden by Payeras. Can excuse the last 3 starts. Tried hard in last on a surface that might not be her best. Was pulling in the early stages routing two back and didn't handle the tight turns on the wet CT track back. Beat just a neck by the 6-time stakes winner Eda 5 back.

**VALUE: 3 GLORIOUS SPRING**

Cuts back from 1M 1/8 stakes at Fresno last out. Got in tight two back on the turf and lost all chance. Prior to that, her form was very good. She won twice routing and finished second three times sprinting on the dirt and one of those was here at Del Mar. Prat gets up. Exotics adder at long odds.

**PICK: 5 SOULMATE**

Mullins gelding takes a drop in class and draws a much better post than the 11 spot he was in last time out. The winner of that race came back to win the G2 Twilight Derby. The runner-up moved up to opt clm 80k and hit the board at 72 (89 Beyer). Mullins has a 21% win rate when he uses this rider, Pereira, for an average win price of \$10.20. Better trip is expected.

**VALUE: 1 TAISHAN**

Hasn't hit the board since a win at OP on the dirt back nearly 2 years ago. That is 11 straight off-the-board finishes. But he's nibbled at this level on the turf. Ran pretty well with Rispoli up four back when beaten just 3 at a higher level on this turf course. Saves ground and grabs a minor placing.
