He's been off a long time and now moves to a new barn (Leonard Powell). Clockers indicate the works coming into this race are sharp. Has had just three poor starts. Two were on the grass and once in last where something went wrong that prompted such a long layoff. Sits a good trip just off the early pace.

Carla Gaines has 3 firsters in this race and this one has been outworking the other two (with a lot of early speed) in the morning drills. Gaines doesn't win often with a 1st timer but Dettori adds intrigue.

VALUE: 3 SPARTA F. C.

No idea if this one can run a step. She was not bet in the debut at GG and came to a walk after about half the race. But she adds Lasix (which means it's possible she bled in there). Trainer got a 9-1 winner shipping in from GG here recently. Female family of G1 winner Emcee (all dirt). Not a strong grass MSW.

She has been in the exacta in all 3 starts (although she's beaten just 10 horses in those 3 starts). Runner-up in last returned to win a MSW with another 90 Beyer Speed Figure. No disgrace when 2nd to Kopion who could be any kind. He'll get some pace to run into here. He's 2 for 3 at this long distance. Excellent distance works on the tab.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 EASTERN OCEAN Claimed this lightly raced 7YO gelding 3 back for 50k from Mark Glatt. Drew the rail in the G2 last out and he was sent to hold position. Not sure that is where he wants to travel and might be allowed to sit back in this spot. At this level two back at LRC as the 6-5 favorite and missed the break while sandwiched early. Rider big ROI when up for Bonde.</p> <p>VALUE: 11 ROGUE SON Been off for over 13 months. Last two starts were at this level and they were good enough to compete in here. Prior trainer Bill Spawr retired so the owners switched him to Craig Lewis. Lewis isn't known for having them cranked up off the break (just 1 for 18 off a layoff of this type). Overall, she has been on the board in all 5 turf starts and that includes most recently when in a blanket photo for the Sunshine Millions F&M Turf Sprint. Breaks quickly (1st or 2nd out of gate in all but 1 start). Working exceptionally.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 AG BULLET Lone try sprinting on the grass came in her second start over this surface. She was tons the best as a 6-1 chance and that is the only time (before today) that she was on Lasix. Cost 220k so expectations are there. Richard Baltas runners have been a bit more live lately. They both won graded stakes after.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 GUY NAMED JOE Trainer Doug O'Neill won this race in '16 with Frank Conversation. He was second a neck in this stakes in 2022 with Mackinnon. Both of those horses were primarily turf runners in So Cal as this one is. Note Rispoli was up in the last two (a win and a 2nd place finish) but is on the top choice.
