She went sub :21 for a quarter at GP two back and almost carried that speed to the win (lost to multiple stakes winner by a nose in that one). Only one subpar run sprinting on the turf and it came at FG in a stakes. Top rider is back up today. VALUE: 6 NOTA BENE Ian Wilkes 5YO mare took a long time to win her first race but has run well since sprinting on the turf. Is coming into this off a sharp win in a similar spot on this turf. But that was due to the fact that pace was so slow early for the winner and this one could not quite get to her late. Well-bred 4YO filly won her first two starts rather easily here and at FG. Bred to run all day. Pace will be more fair for her in this one.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 MUSIC STREET Came off the layoff last out in the same race which the top choice was second. This one started running too late but was moving well in the end. Gets more ground which is what she wants. If the pace is quick she'll be one to deal with late. Leparoux was up for both of her wins and is back. Finished evenly in what appears to be a key race (9th and 10th won back in MSW). Wasn't helped by the post in the debut at KEE. Third start in a form cycle today. Two solid works. Might love the added ground.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 DOMINA Have to believe a filly by Empire Maker is not going to be at her best at 7F. So the debut was little more than a prep for her to stretchout here. Trainer is 6 for 27 with a second time starter going sprint to route. 4 of those 6 winners were off the board in the debut. Has 4 works since the debut. Expecting one to sit just off the other. Serious run behind Zozos last out in the stakes. He pressed/set a :45 half in there. He is back on Lasix today. Won two straight during the winter. Unlucky to lose 3 back at OP. The one to beat.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 SANTOS DUMANT He might end up being the controlling speed or just behind the top choice. There isn't any other speed in the race so if the top two slow it down, they could go all the way together. 4 for 5 in the exacta going this distance. That was on a good track and she just didn't appear to like the surface (beaten 22 lengths at 5-1). She won easily two back when Beschizza put her on the lead. 2nd and 3rd from that race won right back. Last two works look serious. Cuts back to a sprint. Should be tough today.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 TAMMY TAP TAP TAP Moves to the dirt for the first time. She might like the switch. Her sibling, Lighthouse Bay, won a G1 on dirt back in 2013. Think this filly is better than she showed on grass last out. Was 3rd in stakes two back sprinting at TP. Trainer Bauer has spotted them well here so far at the meet (10 of 14 in the money). Thought the third in the JC Oaks next in New York was a massive effort. The winner is a Chad Brown filly who has earned \$1.1M and was a Grade 1 winner two starts earlier. Was it the third start off a break, drop in class or Lasix that woke her up in last?</p> <p>VALUE: 7 LOVELY PRINCESS Came right back off the layoff to win at 6-1. 4th from that race returned to get nosed out vs. similar at BEL last week. Runner-up has picked up checks in Grade 1 races in the US and overseas. Her last two wins were on turf with give in the ground and she worked well on a sloppy dirt track prepping for this. All 4 who ran back from the last start fired (8th and 10th won MSW). The winner was second in a good opt clm behind a stakes type runner the race following the Ky Derby in his next start. Has the hot riding Tyler Gaffalione up. Will be forced to send from the inside.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 SPACE Bill Mott shows up here for Claiborne Farm. This one hasn't run since September as a 2YO and comes into this a 1st time gelding and with the addition of Lasix. Works are good highlighted by a 3rd best of 65 to work on 5/13 over this track.
