PICK: 1 JETOVATOR This gelding has won 3 of 4 at the distance. He's 11 of 17 in the money (5 wins) on the SA turf course. Takes a drop back to clm 50K in this spot but that appears to be his level at the moment. Has some tactical speed but is best finishing late. Inside post is a concern.			PICK: 7 INTO YELLOWSTONE Trainer Peter Miller uses this move a lot. He likes to drop into maiden claiming it spots where his runner has poor form. Both starts for this 2YO 75k purchase were full of issues and traffic. Worked well enough at SLR in 3 works. Rider won 1 of 4 for Miller here at SA.			PICK: 4 RAHM Two starters in the race for Peter Miller (#5 Mega Moon is the other). Drew the rail most recently and had to wait to move but did so to break his maiden. Not much speed in the race so Smith might send him early. He had major trip trouble in the first two times out.			PICK: 4 TOP GUN TOMMY Claimed from last when he shipped in from MTH to run well when 2 nd by a half. The top 2 finishers were well clear of the rest. Winner came back to win 20k claiming at Fresno in his next start. That was just his 3 rd sprint in his career. Showed he can finish going short.	
VALUE: 5 RAGER 6YO gelding is in good form now. He won 4 of his last 11 and was beaten just a nose in the last start at GG. The winner of that race had been third beaten just 3 in a 75k stakes in the race prior. Has two wins on this grass course (7 of 10 in the money). Late run today.			VALUE: 5 ELEVEN OUT OF TEN Did no running in the debut back in July as a 53-1 chance at Del Mar. Homebred drops in this spot and comes in with strong drills for this comeback. Trainer having a good meet with 10 of 28 in the money. Dam won 300k for this same ownership. Check the betting.			VALUE: 1 WORSE READ SANCHEZ Closer might be pace dependent in this one. He had the blinkers added two back and so far hasn't helped. The Cal-bred was trapped on the rail behind a slow pace last out and just didn't have anywhere to run for most of the race. If pace develops, he has a chance.			VALUE: 7 BLAMELESS 7YO gelding won routing on the turf 3 starts ago and then cut back to 5F before going a route again. Now cuts back here once more. Showed good speed sprinting on the dirt in the races previously so it's likely Payeras is going to send. Wide post advantageous here.

PICK: 5 GRACELUND GARY Hard to understand the ride Berrios gave this one last time out. He allowed him to go an obscene :21.1 going a mile. Obviously, he tired but gamely hung in for third. Moves to Hernandez for this. Should be calmer with a start under his belt. Expecting better today.			PICK: 2 BAJAN BASHERT Handled the turf pretty well but think she is bred more for the dirt. All 3 dirt efforts prior to moving to the grass are good enough to win this one. JJ Hernandez was aboard first time out when he was second by a head at Del Mar at 16-1. Cutback is ideal for this one.			PICK: 4 KINGS RIVER KNIGHT Has speed routing but will take a backseat early to the rail runner who is a sprint speed monster. Last time sprinting on this turf he ran a nose behind superstar The Chosen Vron (millionaire who is 13 for 17 in his career, G1 winner). Rider Hernandez is 3 for 3 riding him.			PICK: 7 VULIN 4 th or better in 4 of her last 5 starts. Both of her starts on the dirt (in the last two) were strong. She was 2 nd at 11-1 two back despite a very wide trip. Drew wide in last but was a game second pressing the pace. 5 th last out returned to win at this level at LRC next out.	
VALUE: 3 WED Won a Group 2 in France and kept top level company since. Slow start from the 10 post two back in the G2 and she just didn't really make a run in there. Came off the layoff and sprinted in last. That was likely a prep for a longer run. First Lasix and blinkers come on.			VALUE: 6 SCARY FAST RIDE Has two siblings who both have earned just short of 200k. Added blinkers in last and ran pretty well. But she started slowly from the rail. Draws better outside. Does have some missed works in the tab but also a few very decent moves. We haven't seen her best yet.			VALUE: 5 NONE ABOVE THE LAW Won half a million dollars for Peter Miller. Is cutting far back in distance and blinkers on for this one. Another one who was 2 nd to the top Cal-bred The Chosen Vron last time in a sprint (in this race last year). Lost to the top pick 3 times this year. Will make a late run.			VALUE: 10 EXCLUSIVE JONI This is a pretty weak field and this one has faced better in her career. Cut back last out and was slow early and 5-wide. Think she is better routing. Berrios sticks with her going long. Ran up into traffic two back and really lost any shot. She doesn't have much to beat.

PICK: 7 SENSIBLE MOVE

Ran 2nd on the move to the turf at 17-1 in the start three back. Wide post and flat effort 2 back at 21-1 vs. similar at DMR. Blinkers on in last and it helped but she ran into a lot of traffic trouble that might have cost her the win. Should get plenty of pace to set her up.

VALUE: 3 SHE'S A BIT SASSY

Thought she was a bit too close to the quick pace two back and she paid the price later in the race. Came from far back and ended up steadying 3 back in a better-than-it-looks effort. Like the move to Rispoli as he is a bit more patient on the turf. Will get a good trip.

VALUE: 5 AMERICAN FLYER

Dam is a sib to the 2010 G1 Met Mile winner who also won the G1 Whitney, Tizway. Think the pedigree leans dirt. Didn't have a great trip in the 1M route on turf. Blinkers added for this and moves to the dirt. Trainer gets hot around here. Major overlay 2nd time out.
