 This seems to be a 2-horse race. This one looked great winning the debut at 5.5F on the turf at ELP. He was 11-1 but sat perfectly and ran away from the field late. 2nd won the 243k Indian Summer two starts later. 3rd out of there won a KD MSW and was beaten just 2 3/4 in the G2 Bourbon after. The trainer is 4 for 12 in turf sprints in allw or opt clm here in So California.

VALUE: 4 ALWAYS ON CAY
 Tried the turf for the first time in the Speakeasy. He was 50-1 in there and didn't get out of the gate very well. He was passing some from dead last late in the race. Has turf in the pedigree. Could be a bit closer to the pace with a clean break. Good to see Smith stay up. Is likely for a minor award.

Dam was a G2 winner, G1 placed on dirt. Sib was a multiple stakes winner on the dirt and won over 600k. He is one of the obvious win candidates. Check the toteboard for more clues here.

 Almost have to treat this one like a first timer since he was climbing so badly in the debut. He just never got a chance to run normally and it was basically a throw-out. Worked heads up with recent winner Coach Prime (won by daylight Friday). Sib to Baffert G1 two-year old winner Eight Rings.

 She was beaten just a neck to G1 winner Porta Fortuna in Ireland despite an awful start. That winner was recently 2nd in the BC Juvenile Filles Turf. Two starts locally have not gone well. Winner two back just won an op clm on the turf here Friday. Checked pretty badly in the lane last out. Prat up.

Toss the last start at LRC when she stumbled pretty badly. Massive weight break from the 124 she has been carrying. She can close strongly but also able to put herself into the early mix. Square price.

VALUE: 6 NEVER SWAY
 She won first off the claim 3 back and then outran her odds when 3rd in a 12k claimer at SA afterwards. Either of those efforts makes her a viable candidate for the win in here. Forgive the turf start last time out. It was a tougher field and she hasn't shown she wants anything but fast dirt track.

Has route speed but the cutback puts her off a fast pace. She's 4 for 7 on the turf. Started too late as the fav in her last start. Figures to be really charging in the lane. Wins if she moves in time.

VALUE: 7 M IS FOR MAGIC

It's hard to know how she'll transfer to the Drysdale barn. Her prior form when running for Eurton was very good. She won 2 of her last 4 starts and encountered trouble in many of her recent starts. Her win two back was at this distance here at 12-1. Gets a big rider change today to JJ Hernandez.

He earned a big Beyer two back when second at LRC well clear in front of the rest of them in there. Hasn't run a bad race at this lower level and is facing likely the softest field he's seen. Not automatic but certainly a big chance in here.

VALUE: 4 BOLTS DESTINY

It might be a bit too early to give up on him. He's bred well and more for the dirt. Damsire is a well-known dirt sprint influencer. Off slow in debut in a MSW going long from the rail. Very few horses can overcome that in a strong race. Drew the 11 post last out and was wide. Could wake up today.

Has speed but there is much more speed to her outside. Might end up with a good trip if Pereira can rate her off the pace. Form is good.
