Bellamy Road

Surprise entrant after it was thought he was going to return sprinting; hard to question the trainer, who finished 1-2 in this race in 2004; he's the absolute main speed of this event and the Ky. Derby race looks a lot better than on paper as he was one of the few horses among wicked early fractions to finish in the 1st half of the field; been working like he's ready for a biggie and his 2-back Wood win is still the best Beyer speed figure of any 3-year-old this year; the one to catch and beat.

Andromeda's Hero

Finished right behind uncoupled barnmate Bellamy Road in the Kentucky Derby; deep closer seemed very much at home going 12 furlongs in the Belmont Stakes 2-back; adds blinkers for the 1st time, which is a very profitable angle from the barn, who finished 1-2 in this race last year; wasn't within range of similar in the Jim Dandy over the track; deep closer may race a bit closer to the pace with the new hood, but can't help but rate him a notch below the top contenders.

Chekhov

Last was probably his best race to date, but it still landed him 4 lengths behind Roman Ruler; 3.3M 2-year-old purchase is out of a stakes-winning dam (8-17, 443K) and regular rider Stevens has 2 wins in this race ('01 Point Given, '95 Thunder Gulch); didn't show up when making first Grade 1 start of career; seems on the improve, but needs to show a bigger kick in the lane to upset this kind.

Freshened after nowhere in 3yo debut over a wet Santa Anita track, the barn surprisingly shipped him east, where the results have been superb; his Dwyer was excellent as he rallied against a Belmont Park speed bias to score a game win over Flower Alley, who validated that win with a Jim Dandy runaway; he was professional, although unspectacular in the Haskell, his first lifetime Grade 1 victory; sib to G1 El Corredor (7-10, 727K) gets 2-for-2 rider Bailey again (3 wins in the Travers), who always seems to be in perfect position in these big spots; would be helped if someone went right after Bellamy Road in the early stages; bounced the last time he paired up 100 Beyers; looking for a peak effort out of him this afternoon as the pick.
