## Route the Field Will Run



1 1/2 MILES. (224) 114th Running THE BELMONT STAKES (Grade I). Purse \$200,000 added. 3-year-olds. By subscription of \$100 each to accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$2,000 to start. A supplementary nomination of \$5,000 may be made on Wednesday, June 2 with an additional \$15,000 to start, with \$200,000 added of which 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 12% to third and 6% to fourth. Colts and Geldings, 126 lbs. Fillies, 121 lbs. Starters to be named at the closing time of entries. The winning owner will be presented with the August Belmont Memorial Cup to be retained for one year, as well as a trophy for permanent possession and trophies will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey and mementoes to the grooms of the first four finishers. Closed Tuesday, February 16, 1982 with 332 nominations.

operation, and has maintained that mark for some 50 years, adds, "How can I like any horse but Woody's? That was one of the greatest races I've ever seen any horse win."  
Frank LaBocetta, who has Air Forbes Won, winner of the Gotham and Wood Memorial at Aqueduct this spring and who was the beaten favorite in the Kentucky Derby against many who will start in this race, is another who favors Linkage.  
"This is not going to be any race for a horse who has to come from out of the clouds. The winner is going to be one who can race on or near the pace and then stay once he gets in front. That's why I like Linkage. He has to be tough after that race in the Preakness."  
Owner Harry Albert, who maintains Gedney Farm and who some years back campaigned the exceptional racehorse Gun Bow, is another who looks to Linkage to win the race.  
"He was off for some weeks until he started in the Preakness and he obviously needed that race. He is going to be a lot tougher and tighter for this race. He comes up to the race perfect on the figures."  
Joe Trovato, who took the NYRA'S Triple Crown for Fillies with Chris Evert, however differs.  
"Conquistador Cielo, who else? With his speed he will put the others away and then go on about his business by himself. That was one of the great races he threw in here last Monday."  
Tommy Walsh, one of the best of the jump riders when he was active in that phase of the sport and who has since become a fine trainer, is another in linkage's camp.
