On May 25, 1996, opening day of the 1996 season, she won allowance race coming from dead last. She would win 4 times at that meet including the \$25,000 Canterbury Oaks making her the 1996 three-year old filly of the year.

She faded rather quickly there and again at the mile next out. Big form reversal in last, just missed at 33-1. Sib to stable star Mr. Jägermeister. Has a quick 5F gate drill a week ago.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 YANKEE AGATE 54-1 in her debut at Tampa but came out running. She came from near last almost got up despite a wide trip. There is some pedigree here. Dam was a 2x stakes winner and sib Summer Revolution won 328k. This one crushed a similar field at Turf Paradise in last. Key race 2 back, 4 comeback winners out of there. Dam a 3x stakes winner at CBY. She benefits from racing coming off the turf.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 LASTING LIGHT Moves to Justin Evans after a pop and stop in last at GG. Evans is one of the all-time leading trainers at Canterbury Park and is very dangerous with a speed type like this. Both turf races were strong at GG. Winner of last won the 50k Golden Circle at PRM at 4-1 (90 Beyer) next. 4th took a 30k claimer at CD at 5-1 in his next start. He won his only two starts for a tag.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 ALOHLOUYA Trainer won at 40-1 a week ago here on opening night. This one drops back from a route when he showed nothing. But the last time sprinting on the dirt was 3 back when 2nd at 37-1 at HOU. Gets the inside post and will save ground. Will finish fast.</p> <p>A) 2,6 B) 1,4,7 C) 3,5</p>

This one has the best early speed in the race. This trainer won 3 of 10 here last year. Quarterhorse jockey will get him going early and try to wire them here.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 FLASHYMEISTER Apprentice rider up in the last 3 starts. Got away slowly in the same race the top choice was 4th in two back at OP. Faced better in last going a mile at OP. Form doesn't look like much but gets class relief today. Diodoro is lethel with recent acquisitions from So Cal here at Canterbury. Was facing much better at Santa Anita and nibbling. Should be in a good spot with Kennedy asking for early position.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 TURN THE SWITCH Very difficult claiming off Peter Miller but Riecken has done well claiming off high profile barns in the past. Has some backclass and isn't facing a very strong field here. Might show a bit of speed from a wide post draw. Moved to Rengstorf before coming to Canterbury and had a decent year. Was unlucky to lose a couple of close races. Trainer 16% off a long layoff at CBY. Sharp works prepping for this.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 WILD BEHAVIOR Leading trainer here in 2020. He gets this runner from Ian Wilkes for Lothenbach Stables. He was a strong 2nd in a 12-horse field two back at 6-1. The TP races can be tough, horses do well transferring to other tracks. Exits a race where he won at 1M 1/8. Been on the board in 5 straight starts. Fonner shippers haven't done well here yet but this one fits very well in this spot.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 BE DONE DADDY Very solid trainer from Arizona claimed this one 3 back for 12k three back. He moved him to turf last out and he came flying late to run 2nd by less than a length at 6-1. That was first with this rider. He has 3 wins and 5 in the exacta from his last 6 who drop in half in and off at even money or less. 5th beaten 7 from last won next at LS for 20k. Connections dropping for a win here. Will be a pretty low price.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 PRINCE LEO Lightly raced Ark-bred was claimed last time out for 12k. He was third beaten just a head for 20k two back when facing Ark-bred claimers. Trainer won 2 of 3 starts on opening night here. Looks as if he'll be closing from far back. He is 16 for 31 (52%) with 25 in the money (81%) when off as the favorite at Canterbury. He brings in good Arizona form here having a win and a 3rd in Arizona stakes. Draws well. Makes a late charge.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 GOT EVEN SMARTER Won 4 back at 16-1 with Mawing up. This Mn-bred has always hinted at bigger things. Obviously did not like the Hawthorne surface as he barely ran last time out. Did run 2nd on an off-track here in '19. Drop should help. Comes running in the lane.</p> <p>A) 4 B) 3,6,8 C) 1,5</p>
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
