Third and fourth from there came back to win MSW at Del Mar. Blinkers come on and she has some sharp works since last. Will need to be caught.

Didn't take much action for a Baffert debut runner but the winner was the other Baffert who may have been a bit more well meant. Fast work just one week ago here.

That is back to back strong runs in the lane. Will get more pace to work with in this spot.

Won for just the second time last out. He pressed early and gamely got it done as the favorite. He has speed to get into the race but might actually sit perfectly behind the pace. Hasn't run fast enough yet to win but he may be able to make that up with a good trip. Ran two back and that cost him the win. 11 of 13 in the money on grass.

Hasn't been out since March and has only two starts so far in 2025. But 3 of his last 5 races would win this. The trainer, Shirreffs, is 1 for 3 off similar layoffs (or longer) and Rispoli riding. Has some fast works at Del Mar. He'll have plenty of pace to chase. Last time he drew the rail was 3 back (with Rispoli) and he crushed saving ground.

VALUE: 9 TIGER IN MY TANK

Kyle Frey was aboard when this one went wire to wire 4 back, from the rail, at 50-1 at Del Mar. For no reason, he was moved to the turf in the next two starts (one going long) and didn't run at all. Nothing wrong with the most recent start when a close 4th in a starter allowance. Will have to deal with other speed. Trainer has won 24% in '25.

This 7YO horse was a G1 winner at Del Mar back in 2021. He won the Hollywood Derby wire to wire at 11-1. Beaten a neck with a career high 101 Beyer just 4 starts ago but that was in Nov 2022. Cut back to a sprint last time out. He drew a tough rail and broke near last. He rallied up the inside to make it interesting at 47-1. Better post here.

VALUE: 2 NESSO'S LASTHARRAH

Ultra-consistent type makes his first start in stakes in this spot. Been in the exacta in 10 of 12 since the debut. Horses who have speed going long often do quite well on the cutback to this distance on the grass. 2 for 2 in a sprint at 6F on the grass. Figures to take back in this spot and look for one run. Form good enough to consider.

Had almost zero chance to close into a 1:13.4 pace two back two after the slow start from the rail. Comes in with 4 sharp works for this. Back to fantastic turf rider Berrios. Pulls the upset.

VALUE: 13 MISO PHANSY

If we didn't see the last two races she might be a lower price on the board. She had a great winter/spring racing season with 6 in the exacta from 6 starts. Never really made an impact at 1M in the G2 start two back but that was off a layoff. Toss the dirt try in the last start. Widest posts are advantageous at 6.5F on the turf at Santa Anita.

She nosed out a last out Florida-bred off a maiden special win vs. statebred company in her last start. Needs to improve off of that race to beat males in here. Top call rider chooses here of the two for Biancone.

Never easy to make the first start in stakes company as this one did. He dropped out of that stakes and won the next time he ran. Runner-up to the 3 for 3 John Sadler colt from So Cal, Hey Nay Nay, who won the G3 Del Mar Juv Turf easily next at 1-1 (78 Beyer). 8th out of last ran third by 3 next in the 150k Bongard stakes on grass next.

He does have the backclass to beat these. Was third in the start two back for 12k. The winner of that race won twice at 12k since. 4th won next time out for 10k. Check betting.

The one she dueled with on the lead in there ran 4th beaten two in a 125k MSW at KD next at 22-1 odds. Blinkers off. Bred well for turf. Not facing a strong group.
