Consistent filly beaten in photos 3 straight. Comes from behind and cuts back. She used to be a miler (7 for 11 in top 3 at 1M on turf). Sharp work a week ago.

Group 3 winner in the start three back and beaten a neck in a Group 2 at Goodwood two back. She was in with very tough company in the last start when she was a bad last. Has speed which will have her in a good spot. Trainer not known for Euro shippers but this one is classy. Perfect fit for the conditions.

The female family produced Destin, Creative Cause and Vexatious (all G1 winners). Works are not what Bob Baffert is known for so tab the betting action here.

VALUE: 8 CLEAR AND PRESENT

This is a case where the clocker report (which is out at 7PM PST the night before) has a major impact in the decision to move this one up. The clockers state he has been outworking older runners including a G1 winner Stronghold on July 4th. D'Amato is 3 for 12 here at DMR with a 2YO firster sprinting on dirt.

The 1st and 3rd place came from last. Rail (not the place to be at 6.5F in the start 2 back). Blinkers didn't work 3 back.

VALUE: 7 HIGHPLAINSDRIFTER

Figures to be one of the main closers in this one. He catches a field that has quite a few that want to be on the lead so the pace might work to his advantage. Hasn't taken a lick of action at the windows but has outrun those odds of late. Low percentage rider has been aboard most of his starts. Good price on closer.

The pace was too fast in last and she tired. Top 3 there all closed from off the pace. She cannot be working any better.

VALUE: 3 CAN'T SLEEP

Carla Gaines has been very patient with this mare. She has never missed the board in her 7 starts. She likely needed the last start. She chased the wire to wire winner in there behind what was a pace a bit on the slow side on that turf course. Overcame a lot of trouble to win 2 back. Rider got to know her in last.

Speedball is an all-or-nothing type. He will go right to the front in here, as he did in the G3 at CD in the last start. He has been able to carry that speed in 2 graded stakes wins. Given the fact that he tired last out it could mean others will not respect him on the lead and let him go. The works for this are sizzling.

Moved to Peter Eurton to start the 2026 season. He stumbled and lost the rider 3 back. Broke on time in the start two back and went wire to wire with a top Beyer of 96. Saffie Joseph winner in last got loose on the lead and crushed. G1 winners were 4th and 5th in there. The pace should set him up nicely here.

VALUE: 2 BARTHOLDY

He doesn't win out of turn (4 wins in 25 starts). But he often outruns his odds. He's been third 11 times and is graded stakes placed 5 times in his career so far. He has never missed the board on the dirt. He's handled this dirt course just fine. Baze has been up for his best races. Beat some of these in the last few.

Draw a line through the last start. She started from the rail and that is a tough spot at 6.5F especially if the runner doesn't have speed. Sire has been better with runners going long (14% route, 8% sprint) on the turf. This filly is 4 for 4 in the exacta at the route distance. Back to Hernandez. 3 solid works for this.

VALUE: 3 LADY IN PARIS

Won two races overseas going long on the turf. She ran well first out for D'Amato when she closed well for second by just a head. Toss the start two back. She likely bled which is why she was sent to the US to add Lasix which she did last out. Works are very sharp. Slow 5F turf drill indicates she is ready here.
