1 3/16 MILES. (1:52²) 124th Running of THE PREAKNESS. Grade I. Purse \$1,000,000 Guaranteed. 3-year-olds. \$10,000 to pass the entry box, with starters to pay \$10,000 additional. Supplemental nominations may be made in accordance with the rules, upon payment of \$100,000, with 65% of all monies to the winner, 20% to second 10% to third, and 5% to fourth. Weights: 126 pounds for colts and geldings, 121 lbs. for fillies. Starters to be named through the entry box on Wednesday, May 12, 1999, three days before the race, by the usual time of closing. The Preakness field will be limited to fourteen (14) entries and shall be determined on the Wednesday immediately preceding the day of the race. In the event that more than fourteen (14) horses are properly nominated and pass through the entry box by the usual time of closing, the field shall be the fourteen (14) horses that have accumulated the greatest career money earnings, as determined by the Racing Secretary. In application of the above-described rule, each horse will be separately considered without regard to identity of its owner. In the event that the Racing Secretary determines that operation of the above-described rule results in two or more horses being equally qualified for the fourteenth position, the Racing Secretary shall select the fourteenth horse by lot. If the rules described in this paragraph result in the exclusion of any horse, the \$10,000 entry fee previously paid will be refunded to the owner of said horse. The above conditions notwithstanding, no horse which earns purse money in the Kentucky Derby shall be denied the opportunity to enter and start in the Preakness Stakes. Post position shall be determined as follows: A nontransferable lot number shall be drawn for each horse named as a starter at the closing. The lot number drawn for each starter shall determine the numerical order for selection of post position. Selection of post position shall be made by each owner of a horse (or, if more than one, the owners collectively) or the authorized agent of the horse's owner(s). Horses having common ties through ownership or training shall be treated separately for purposes of selecting post position. Detailed rules governing the post position draw process are available from the Racing Secretary's office, and will be distributed prior to the closing. A replica of the Woodlawn Vase will be presented to the winning owner to remain his or her property. Closed with 396 nominations, and 11 late nominations.



A CLOSER LOOK

Preakness

Torrid Sand

When assessing chances of Preakness candidates who did not run in the Derby, remember this, 26 of 30 exacta finishers from last 15 runnings of the Preakness made their previous start in the Derby; 28 of the last 30 exacta finishers last raced at Churchill; Sand a distant 3rd in the Ark. Derby which was not a strong Derby prep; winner Valhol ran 15th in the Derby while Answer Lively ran 10th, Ecton Park 12th; longshot status warranted.

Kimberlite Pipe

Sellers off Vicar to pilot 'Pipe; everything went wrong early in Derby when steadied and bumped on the first turn while racing 4 wide; with a clean run around the first turn in the Preakness, 'Pipe a candidate to race in the first flight; nonetheless, is this colt good enough to win the Preakness? based on the horses he was trading wins with in Louisiana before being outrun in the G1 Blue Grass and the Derby, the answer is no; on the plus side, if banking on a clean early trip to move 'Pipe forward, odds will be huge; backers will be quick to note 'Pipe was only beaten 2 3/4 lengths in the Derby.

Cat Thief

Derby run huge factoring in a Churchill strip that was not favoring speed; winless at 3 but has been a serious factor in all 4 of the 2-turn races; in fact, has not been beaten by more than 1 1/4 lengths in 6 career starts around 2 turns; speed to stay clear of trouble all the stalking/positional speed encountered around the first turn of the Derby; Thief evidently thriving on activity as Beyer figures on the rise and he passed his stablemate in May 11 Preakness work; did not accomplish that feat in the final Derby drill; trainer Lukas has won the Preakness 4 times and each winner did not win the Derby; major player not only for gimmicks, but for the win.

Badge

G3 Gotham win decisive but the field was weak; Apremont staggered the length of the stretch yet lasted for 2nd money; mixed signals towards G1 Wood Mem. field; Adonis was beaten up before finishing 14 1/4 lengths back in the Derby; Best Of Luck did return to run 2nd in the G2 Withers; big knock is fact Badge's last race was not at Churchill; last horse to have finished in the top 3 in the Preakness after last racing in New York; 22-1 shot Rock Point in '89.

Menifee

Steam horse supreme; late-charging 2nd in Derby after weaving his way to daylight in the stretch; problem now is the price; has been installed as the 5-2 favorite after being sent off at 7-1 for the Derby; with a closing style, Menifee is far from ensured a clean trip; late bursts of speed in G1 Blue Grass and Derby runs came well into the stretch; Charismatic was moving with a purpose on the far turn of the Derby well before Menifee found his "A" stride; simply wondering if Menifee is destined to come up short once again; stretch run at Pimlico is shorter than stretch run at Churchill (by 82.5 feet) and the turns are also tighter; deservng of heavy action off last 2 races but running style leaves outcome in doubt right to the finish.

Charismatic

Misjudged by Lukas earlier in the year but D. Wayne now has the Derby winner 100% cranked; won the Derby around the far turn when Antley moved the former claimer into striking position; from there Charismatic had dead aim on Worldly Manner and Cat Thief while getting the all-important first run on the closers; big move on far turn of Derby brings back memories of how Real Quiet came within a nose of winning the Triple Crown in '98; first 4 Lukas win Preakness winners did not win the Derby; this colt a serious threat to put an end to that trend; respect tons.

Excellent Meeting

Last filly to win the Preakness? Nellie Morse in 1924; Meeting ran well to finish 5th in the Derby after having one horse beaten after the first 4fs; however, where was the early interest which led to 2 G1 wins and a G2 win prior to the Derby? perhaps the fact Meeting was no longer racing The Happy Hopper, Dreams Galore and Tout Charmant led to having so much ground to recover; rebounded from the "roller" Derby with a :59 5f work but still have to wonder what the Derby took out of Meeting; if going to back a lady, Silverbulletday gets the call.

Patience Game

G3 Derby Trial winner carries an interesting angle; Cherokee Run and Alydeed both won the Derby Trial before running 2nd in the Preakness; however, they had more speed; Alydeed pressed the pace from the start before being on the lead after the first 6fs; Run was a forward factor on the backstretch before hitting the front with 3/16s of a mile to run; not convinced Game is capable of taking the track from the bulk of the field at this level; more of a stalker and is prone to the same rough trip around the first turn which plagued multiple horses in the Derby; ask for real "value."

Adonis

Came to hand in a hurry when blinkers were added for G2 Wood Mem. score; unfortunately, trip in Derby resembled a Ben Hur sequel without the chariots; Three Ring crashed into Adonis out of the gate leading to Adonis racing inside of where the rail normally is; Adonis had to fight his way back into a path which would lead to avoiding running on the turf; a trip-handicapper's delight but like others entered, have to wonder if Adonis is talented enough to win; Zito fans will note Louis Quatorze finished 16th in the Derby before winning the '96 Preakness; Adonis does not have the speed Quatorze used to steal the Preakness on the front; price will be big if willing to toss Derby run and rely on more Zito Triple Crown heroics.
