paths off the inside, advanced mildly to regain what was lost seven furlongs from home settling back to be just off the pace once more, began another small advance five furlongs out and tucked inside with nine-sixte enths to go, was given a nudge midway on the turn and bid to be on near even terms with five-sixteenths remaining, traded a small bump and brush with NATIONAL TREASURE at the quarter pole before seizing command, straightened a way in the inside route into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, then be gan to drift out through to the finish seven path despite being flashed the crop to the right side and an active leftrein but held safe even though giving away ground to the end. FORTE just off the inside through the first turn, raced four wide in pursuit from mid pack down the backstretch, tipped out five wide through the far turn coming under coaxing and being flashed the crop to the right side when drifting slightly at the three-eighths pole, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and offered up a mild kick closing belatedly to just get up for the place honors in the final jumps. TAPIT TRICE away last without incident, came under coaxing and chased just off the inside through the first turn before tipping five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide at the nine-sixteenths and commenced a bid on the front stacking outside a trio just off the leader at that station, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in offering up a mild bid but was collared in the final strides for the place. honors and forced to settle for the show. HIT SHOW four then three wide through the opening turn, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch just off the top pair, tucked three wide into the far turn coming under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths between rivals among a quartet just off the leader, got nudged by ANGEL OF EMPIRE to the two path at the three-eighths, tipped three wide at the head of the stretch and kept on to dead heat with his main rival at the finish.
