Made some headway late in Aqueduct's G1 Wood Memorial while less than 2 lengths off the guy next door here, but the try lost some of its luster when the top 2 returned to run poorly in Kentucky; he doesn't have much early foot and though he worked well her last week, don't think the blinker addition is going to help him take full advantage of the inside draw; nice to see an old local hero enticed to take the call, but this guy looks to have his work cut out for him today.

Teeth of the Dog

This guy has only run 4 times and his Wood effort off the break while tackling winners for the initial time is still impressive despite the heat's subsequent lack of productivity from the top 2 finishers; versatile colt enters this on the improve from a figure standpoint and he's been given plenty of time to get over that career best Beyer so another move forward could be in the cards while tackling some added real estate that he figures to appreciate; price should be right to give him an underneath exotics look.

Pretension

Field's lone local winner gutted out the score when shipped here last time, but it came over easier foes than he'll tackle today; New York bred looks to be a useful router, but his efforts in graded events on the Triple Crown trail are likely a better indicator of where he fits in here; looms a big price.

Zetterholm

New York bred has really come to hand of late and looked particularly good running away with his restricted stakes debut in the one turn heat at Aqueduct last month; barn is having a great season and this guy has proven that he can fire his late kick at 2 turns, but these look to be a little too much for him right now.

I'll Have Another

Kentucky Derby winner has been quite good this year but he did get a nice trip and setup in running down Bodemeister 2 weeks ago; expecting he'll find himself closer to the pacemakers early in the here and he clearly has little trouble with the trip; he's certainly capable if he keeps improving, but it looks as if the guy he ran past late last time holds a tactical advantage this time and it could be tough for him to overcome over this strip; main danger.

Optimizer

Didn't do much running after finding some trouble in the Derby after a weak spin in the G1 Arkansas Derby; late runner isn't going to get a contested clip in front of him here and will likely have too much to do in the lane to prove a factor; in his current form we can't back him regardless of price.

Cozzetti

Outside drawn colt has been better on the figure scale of late and he wasn't far off the others when well behind Bodemeister in the Arkansas Derby; he's only run a couple of times on dirt, but he did work sharply at Churchill earlier in the week for this; won't have it easy from out here.
