Snow Chief went right after Groovy, prompted the pace into the backstretch while saving ground, engaged the leader racing into the far turn, put that one away entering the stretch and, after drawing off, maintained his advantage under strong handling while drifting out slightly.

Ferdinand, outrun for six furlongs, moved through along the inside while rallying leaving the far turn and finished well to best the others.

Broad Brush stumbled after the start, was carried out slightly while moving up outside horses at the first turn, remained well out in the track while racing forwardly until near the stretch and tired.

Badger Land ducked out following the start and failed to be a serious factor. Miracle Wood was never close. Groovy sprinted right to the front, drifted out in front of Clear Choice at the first turn, remained outside Snow Chief while making the pace, held on well to the stretch but had nothing left.

Clear Choice, steadied between horses when Groovy came out racing into the first turn, raced within easy striking distance for six furlongs and tired badly.
