

ON THIS DATE (1991) – On August 24th, 1991, TIMELESS PRINCE won the 1st Smile Handicap. The Joey Shushan trained, Lester's Partners owned Mn-bred paid \$10.80 to win. Timeless Prince was already a 5-time stakes winner at Canterbury Downs and would win the 1992 Minnesota Classic. He was the 1990 Canterbury Horse of the Year and is in the Hall of Fame.

Looks to be sent from the inside and try to take the wire to wire as he did at a mile on the dirt in a maiden win in a race that was taken off the turf. Faced a good field 4 back in an op clm at OP and was beaten just over a length.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 TIN BADGE Trainer Clinton Stuart claimed this one back for 20K after losing him three back. He added blinkers most recently and it produced a 12-1 win on this turf with Harr aboard. This rider has been riding great lately especially on grass. 3 for 4 in the exacta on this turf. Bred well on both sides for the leading quarterhorse trainer here, Olmstead. 4th straight he has drawn the widest post.
