Turbo Launch gained the lead outside Expect The Best nearing the six furlongs pole, was rated on an open lead to the far turn, responded when set down for the stretch run and held Lost Kitty safe while being kept under a drive until inside the final seventy yards before finishing under a vigorous hand ride. Lost Kitty, outrun early, began to advance on the backstretch, was put to the whip and asked for her best on the far turn, brushed with Rising Writer in the upper stretch, then continued willingly in the final furlong. Rising Writer, never far back, brushed with Lost Kitty in the upper stretch, continued gamely but was outfinished. Jockey Powell aboard Rising Writer lodged an objection against Lost Kitty for interference entering the stretch but it was not allowed. Courtly Native, in hand while outrun early, finished well and was best of the rest although never in contention. Amber Tutu, in good position for five furlongs, tired. Expect The Best raced forwardly to midway on the backstretch and gave way. Singins mary was also finished early.
