The Tampa races can be tough. They thought enough of him to try stakes here last year in the Shakopee Juvenile where the winner was the Ky Derby runner-up Two Phil's. Has speed and will get a good position. Retains regular rider Quinonez here.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 1 TOUR THE WORLD</b>                  Just 1 for 23 on the turf but think he'll get a good trip from the inside post here. He's a big closer so he will just save ground and run in the lane. Did just that 2 back when getting to the top two late while settling for third. Faced better here last year. Trainer wins a fair amount at this track. Dam won over 200k for these connections in 2015 – 2017. She won the Minnesota Distaff in 2016. Robertson is 19 for 52 (37%) w/ 31 in the money (60%) MSW to maiden claiming at Canterbury. Gets Lasix in here for the first time. Top rider Hernandez aboard.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 SILENT SAILOR</b>                  Has some tactical speed and tends to break quickly. He's been out of the gate first or second in 7 of 9 on the dirt. Was sluggish and wide in last. Have to think that was simply a prep to get him started in this '23 season. Rider was up for a couple in the money runs with him last year. Many of those were for Robertson. He is 21 for 61 (33%) with 43 in the money (71%) with a shipper into CBY who last started at OP. 4<sup>th</sup> in last was the Northern Lights Debutante runner-up from 2022, Thunders Rocknroll.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 HONEY BELLA</b>                  Another for Mac Robertson. This one was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2022 Minnesota Oaks at 1M 70 yards at nearly 9-1. Leading rider Hernandez gets up. Last two came on turf but the pedigree doesn't really lean in that direction. **PICK: 6 LO LO'S LAUGHTER**

This is sprint on sprint breeding. All of the best from the female family were sprinters. Sire was a multiple G1 winner sprinting and his best offspring were sprinters. Trainer is 2 for 2 starting a 4YO+ in the debut (once here a year ago). He's 8 for 38 (21%) with a firster at CBY for this ownership. Check for tote action.

**VALUE: 9 BRIARTOWN**

Was runner-up first off the claim at OP in MSW most recently. That isn't easy to do there as those races are very strong. The winner of last was 3<sup>rd</sup> beaten 11 in the 5-horse Golden Circle stakes at PRM last week. Trainer about 13% second off the claim. Must always keep an eye out for where Harry Hernandez ends up.

**PICK: 7 GOLDEN GOPHER**

She's an honest check-getter. She's been in the top 2 in 9 of 11 starts on the turf (7 of 9 here at CBY). One of the misses was 4 back when she was steadied at 4-1 odds. Bridgmohan was aboard in the last 3 starts and he won 2 of them. Trainer Joel Berndt is going to have a huge meet. He has many live Lothenbach runners.

**VALUE: 9 FAST TO FORTUNE**

2009 Kentucky Derby winning trainer with the 50-1 longshot Mine That Bird is right here with this TUP shipper. All 3 of her wins have come on the grass so far. Went fast early and was game in holding them at bay last out at nearly 5-1. Doesn't need the lead but can sit just off the pace. Seems well-spotted in here.

**PICK: 2 THUNDERS ROCKNROLL**

Was a sharp winner in the debut here as the 7-5 fav last August. She ran well for second in the Northern Lights but she was 2-5 in there. The winner could be a good one as that was just her second start after a 12-length debut win in the race prior. She hasn't run back. 3<sup>rd</sup> from there won a 100k opt clm at OP in Apr.

**VALUE: 5 CHECKCASHINGCONNIE**

This is another Mac Robertson filly. She was strong in the debut win before showing little in the same Northern Lights the top choice comes out of. She's getting Lasix for the first time here so she might've bled last out. Works are very good and well-spaced. Dam was a stakes winner on the turf at this course.

**PICK: 7 OPTIMAL COURAGE**

There is little question she likes this turf course. She is 4 for 5 here with the lone defeat when she was 2<sup>nd</sup> just flying late but ran into traffic trouble and was beaten less than one. Claimed for 12k and they have kept her protected since (11 starts). Beat open opt clm foes at FG and RP since the claim. A perfect trip.

**VALUE: 4 MIAMI CROCKETT**

5-time winner on the turf was a 5-1 upset winner on dirt in the last start for Harry Hernandez. Different Hernandez takes the call today. Nibbled with similar foes here last year but the form seems better this year with a win and runner-up in the last 3 starts at TUP. He overcame significant trouble to win last out.

**PICK: 10 CROCODILEHUNTER**

Sib to the Mn-bred superstar Thealligatorhunter (10 for 21 in his career) and 2021 Northern Lights winner She's My Warrior. Totally fine with the debut. Was on the rail and veered in. He ran evenly after in a race that was a prep for Mn-bred races. Sire won the G1 Forego at SAR in '14 at 7F. Gets first time Lasix today.

**VALUE: 5 UNDERTOW**

Had one start here last summer and he went off as the 2-1 favorite in a key MSW race. He came up the inside to get close in the end beaten just over one length. Good third at Hawthorne next out. 5<sup>th</sup> from there is an Ill-bred stakes winner now. 2<sup>nd</sup> from most recent start was in the money MSW at OP since then.
