**PICK: 6 DIDIA**

She's less than a length from being a perfect 5 for 5 in the US. The loss last out was still a career best effort as she ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in a G1. She split two Chad Brown runners in that race and finished well in front of \$2.2M earner War Like Goddess. She's faced and beaten much better so far.

**VALUE: 1 TURNERLOOSE**

It's unlikely she could have carved out a better spot for her pace advantage. She is the controlling speed from the rail in a race where there doesn't seem to be much competition for the lead. She split the field in the 2022 G1 Ky Oaks. Nearly took the G2 Jessamine field all the way.

**PICK: 6 BE YOU**

Very well-bred colt for Todd Pletcher and Repole Stable. Dam is a sibling to Constitution, a 3-time G1 winner on the dirt routing (Fla Derby, Clark, Donn in 2014 and 2015). Third from debut is another for Pletcher won a MSW next by over 7 with a 96 Beyer. Bred to love the added ground.

**VALUE: 8 EL MAGNIFICO**

Figures to be a massive price in here but think he could be sitting on a big race. Ran on well in both starts when 2<sup>nd</sup> to uncontested wire to wire winners. Bred to run all day with Street Sense, Bernardini pedigree. Stretchout is ideal. G1 BC F&M Turf winner Shared Account in the line.

**PICK: 6 ALVINA**

Tried routing two back and ran pretty well. She made a middle move to the front before tiring. 3<sup>rd</sup> from that one came back to win in opt clm 80k as did 5<sup>th</sup>. Cut back to a sprint in last and it may have been too sharp for the first time back. 4 solid works for this. She is at the right level.

**VALUE: 11 NU PI LAMBDA**

Older mare was 35-1 in the common race at Del Mar on 8/31. She ran a winning race despite the odds. She had run but was boxed in and couldn't finish. Been in the top three here on the Santa Anita turf 8 of 17 times. Berrios was up for a good effort here 4 back. She needs racing luck.
