\$2 exacta (6-3) paid \$22.40. \$2 triple (6-3-8) paid \$38.20. a-Coupled: Hoxie and late daily double (7-6) paid \$26.40; late daily double pool \$242,730.

Silver Charm assumed an early forward position, raced three wide around the first turn, remained well off the rail down the backstretch, raced three wide around the far turn, closed determinedly while being floated out by **Free House** in the deep stretch and was up in time. **Free House**, outside **Cryp Too** early, took the lead midway through the backstretch, raced slightly off the rail around the turn and into the stretch, drifted out in the late going and gave way grudgingly. **Captain Bodgit** rated kindly early, raced between horses when commencing his rally midway through the far turn, eased outside entering the stretch and closed gamely outside the winner. **Touch Gold** stumbled badly leaving the starting gate, was steadied in a pocket near the half-mile pole, found room along the rail entering the stretch, was steadied in tight quarters inside **Free House** approaching the eighth pole and continued willingly. **Frisk Me Now**, wide in both turns, lacked a serious bid. **Concerto** moved up wide entering the stretch and gave way. **Hoxie** was no factor. **Wild Tempest** bore out leaving the starting gate, saved ground to the backstretch, moved up between horses approaching the far turn, then gave way. **Cryp Too**, fractious behind the starting gate, sped to the front, saved ground and faltered. **Jack At The Bank** was outrun.
